ETON V. HARROW.

Played at LORD'S, Friday, Saturday, July 13, 14.—The Eton and Harrow match was, from unavoidable causes, a sad disappointment. Heavy and continuous rain made it impossible to start the game on the opening day, and though, in the hope of arriving at a definite result, play began soon after half-past ten on Saturday morning, a draw was nearly always inevitable. Perhaps had the first innings been quickly finished off the game might have been played out, but Harrow, on winning the toss, stayed in till half-past one, and from that time it was felt that the match would be a draw. As will be seen below, three innings were completed, Eton being left at the finish with 83 to get to win. On the heavy but not very difficult wicket, the game lacked animation, but for all that it had many good features. Eton were no doubt by far the better side, but their marked superiority in batting was to a considerable extent neutralised by the state of the ground. So far as they were concerned the honours of the match were carried off by C. C. Pilkington and Cunliffe—two of the most promising all-round cricketers who have been associated with Eton for some little time. Cunliffe, who scored 32, and took in all thirteen wickets for 94 runs, bowled in a style that has not been equalled in the Schools' match since F. S. Jackson was at Harrow; while Pilkington, in addition to bowling well, played far and away the best innings in the game. Cunliffe's powers as a bowler were put to an extreme test, as he was unchanged through both innings of Harrow, bowling for two and a-half hours before lunch and an hour and a-half at the end of the afternoon. Bowling left-handed, he showed for a schoolboy considerable variety of pace, and the fact that he could keep on so long without losing his pitch spoke volumes for the excellence of his method. As a batsman he is right-handed. Of the Harrow team, the honours in batting fell to Stogdon, a free and attractive player, who followed up some capital performances at

home by heading the score in each innings. The Harrow boys played up well against a manifestly stronger team than themselves, and in fielding they had a clear superiority. In a social sense, the second day made amends for the disappointment on the Friday, the company after lunch being estimated at between twelve and thirteen thousand. Late in the afternoon the ground was visited by the Princess of Wales, the Duke of York, and Princess Victoria.

Sixty-nine matches have been played, of which Eton have won twenty-eight, Harrow twenty-nine, and twelve have been drawn. This is the generally published record, but Harrow men object very strongly to the game in 1805 being treated as a regular contest between the two schools, contending that it is no more correct to count that than the fixture in 1857 for boys under twenty, which has been rejected. R. B. Hoare's 108 in 1888 was the ninth three-figure innings in the matches between the schools, the previous great scorers having been E. Bayley 152 in 1841; A. K. Watson 135 in 1885; A. W. Ridley 117 in 1871; C. P. Foley 114 in 1886; W. F. Forbes 113 in 1876; A. W. T. Daniel 112 not out in 1880; C. J. Ottaway 108 in 1869; and E. Crawley 100 in 1885.

RUGBY v. MARLBOROUGH.

Played at LORD'S, *Wednesday, Thursday, August 1, 2.*—For the first time since 1886 Rugby beat Marlborough in the annual match between the two schools at Lord's. On a capital wicket the Light Blues, having won the toss, went in first, and by completing an innings for 398, practically made themselves safe from defeat. Stanning, who opened the innings, carried his bat right through for a remarkable score of 152, in which he hit twenty 4's, eight 3's, and eleven 2's. The only blemishes to be urged against him were chances just before completing his 100 and when 140. He and Nickalls had the distinction of putting on 207 runs—of which Nickalls made 109—in an hour and forty minutes for the second partnership. Marlborough began badly, and lost seven wickets for 93, while on the second day they only raised the total to 101. This necessitated a follow on against a majority of 297, and though they did much better on going in again they were all dismissed for 215, which left Rugby victorious by an innings with 82 runs to spare.
