



THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN 1964

Public Schools cricket, like the Stock Exchange, enjoys booms and endures slumps. So long as it also follows the same trend, each boom taking the standard above the previous peak, and each slump stopping short of the previous lowest mark, we need not worry. The 1963 slump continued through the 1964 summer, preceding the Stock Exchange decline by more than a year. The latter which may have been inevitable, was sparked by political policy, which dismayed people at home and angered friends abroad. Of more immediate concern to cricket is the policy aimed at scrapping the Grammar Schools. It will be a particularly sad day for this section of Wisden if those schools disappear. They produced one of the more impressive cricketers of 1964, R. W. Elviss of Leeds.

Overall the standard was perhaps the same as in 1963, the batting rather better but the fielding not so good on the evidence of the leading cricketers, who played in the representative matches at Lord's. Few individual schools had really impressive records and the general lament of the cricket masters was a lack of good spin bowling. In that respect the schools were following the lead of the first-class counties. Yet, by contrast to the latter, several leg-break and googly bowlers figured prominently. The Rest included two against the Southern Schools at Lord's, N. J. Chapman, of Felsted, and A. R. G. James, of Uppingham. Others of their type included F. J. Whidborne, who took 46 wickets and, with D. R. Aers, played a considerable part in making Tonbridge one of the year's leading teams. M. J. Carter had 34 at a cost of only 8.5 for Christ's Hospital, J. S. Moss-Blundell 28 at 12.6 for King's School, Rochester, and J. W. B. Martin of Ipswich School took 42 at 14.5.

There may not have been any really outstanding batsmen, nor bowlers, but all-rounders of good class abounded. The representative sides were so crammed with them that Elviss, who headed both batting and bowling averages in the most successful side Leeds Grammar School have had for several years, batted number 10 for The Rest. The best all-rounder appeared to be G. R. J. Roope who went straight from school at Bradfield to The Oval. He had already taken up cricket as his profession when he played in the boys' games at Lord's. Roope was an opener with both bat and ball. He looked a fine batsman in the making with a sound defence and the ability and willingness to make strong attacking strokes. His bowling was quite fast, based on the in-swinger. Curiously he swung the old ball more appreciably than the new one at Lord's. His record at Bradfield, who lost only once against four wins but

left eight matches drawn, may speak for itself. He averaged 50 with an aggregate of 653 runs and took 49 wickets at 13 runs each.

I hope Roope will be encouraged to maintain both his batting and his bowling at The Oval. Specialisation is fine for a young player whose ability in one branch of the game is obviously more marked than another. The youngster who is equally promising as batsman and bowler should not arbitrarily be asked to sacrifice one of his talents early in his career, when it is doubtful which of the two is going to develop more successfully. In these days the young all-rounder is usually required to concentrate on his bowling. This process may have cost English cricket several fine batsmen in the years of specialisation since the war. A possible example is C. D. Drybrough, who looked an excellent batting prospect as a schoolboy at Highgate. With Oxford and Middlesex he then became a specialist left-arm spin bowler, his batting allowed to rot in one of the tail-end positions. Unfortunately he did not quite make the grade as a bowler. It will be time enough for Roope to decide about specialising four or five years hence when both his batting and bowling have been given every chance to develop. The hope should be that both will develop well together, and that he will remain a genuine all-rounder, the old fashioned but still invaluable type of cricketer who is, alas, not now much encouraged outside Essex.

R. C. Daniels (Eton) was another successful all-rounder at Lord's and an excellent captain. He began the representative games at Lord's by scoring a century for Southern Schools at the rate of one a minute, and he was a particularly good runner. The attack of The Rest was of modest quality, but Daniels looked accomplished enough to score briskly against bowling of emphatically higher standard. He was a particularly strong driver, who was not afraid to lift the ball over the fielders. Thus he had two 6's and twelve 4's in his century. He was also the most successful Southern bowler in the first innings of The Rest, though his future appeared to lie more clearly in his batting than his off-spin bowling. After a curious prancing run his arm was rather low at the moment of delivery and he did not spin the ball much. Chapman, the captain of the other side, was also an all-rounder, and to my eyes he was the best and most mature batsman at Lord's. He was a left-hander who looked equally good all round the wicket. He, like Daniels, made a century in this match, against obviously better bowling, and he went on to score a 50 for the Schools XI against Combined Services. Chapman bowled right handed and flirted with various spins. It seemed that he should in future concentrate on leg-breaks and googlies, for he had obvious talent in that direction.

One all-rounder of whom we saw little was J. L. Hutton, the younger son of Sir Leonard. He had another admirable season for Repton with 532 runs and 32 wickets. Unhappily he played at

Lord's under the severe handicap of an injured back. Thus we were not able to see anything of his fast bowling, and he did not come off with the bat which, unlike his father and older brother, he wields left-handed. His inability to bowl compelled the selectors to switch him to the Southern Schools, and they moved P. W. Neate of St. Paul's to The Rest as their opening bowler. Neate was another all-rounder, as were M. J. Edmonds (City of London), Aers, R. C. Davis (Blundells), P. H. Spray (Bedford) and C. P. Marks (Worksop). Doubtless most of the others who did any bowling and some of the batsmen who did not bowl think of themselves in terms of all-round play. Which is as it should be, for youth is the time for a cricketer to try himself at everything.

Davis had gained experience with Glamorgan's second team as a promising off-break bowler, who definitely imparted considerable spin to the ball, and a batsman whose strength as yet was restricted to the leg side. Neate had enjoyed a fine season for St. Paul's, topping 500 runs from his left-handed batting. This was based on enterprise. He was an eager hooker of anything short, and he believed in hitting the over-pitched ball far and high. His action for quick medium bowling was somewhat tucked up and his arm rather low, but in an age so dedicated to in-swing it was pleasing to find that the out-swinger was his chief weapon. Edmonds, who made nearly 700 runs and took 38 wickets for his school, was a bowler of similar method and pace. He had quite the best action of all the quick bowlers on show. He looked very promising. As a batsman he was perhaps overcome at first by the atmosphere of Lord's, for he lingered one hundred minutes for 24. Yet his style was good and he hinted at the possession of strokes. These he revealed in the second innings, when he cut particularly well, and he deservedly won a place in the chosen Public Schools side.

The left-arm slow bowling of Aers was ordinary, his batting emphatically more positive. He was well equipped all round the wicket, possessed excellent footwork and was ready to leave his ground to challenge the slow bowlers. Spray was also more commended by his batting, which gave him a school average of 70, than his bowling, which consisted of in-swing at gentle medium pace. His batting style was a trifle cramped, but his feet were usually in the right place and he looked a difficult man to dislodge. For ninety minutes against Southern Schools he was just a stodgy opener. When he at last opened out, he looked a different proposition, and his subsequent success in saving the Schools side against the Services was not unexpected. Marks was a disappointment at Lord's, where his batting suffered from his tendency to play across the line of the ball. After two highly successful seasons for Worksop, seasons peppered with centuries, he was in the middle of a bad patch and so did little in representative company. His bowling pace was gentle medium.

J. M. M. Hooper filled an all-rounder's role for Charterhouse, though his function at Lord's was as a batsman. He was a workmanlike player though it is doubtful if he would have won through to the representative side for the second match in a boom year. That was true also of N. C. D. Craig of Winchester. The frailties of both were exposed by the spin of Elviss and Chapman. Craig had good back foot strokes, but his style was awkward and stiff wristed. A grip at the top of the handle was no help to him in playing the spinners. R. C. Constant (Sherborne) and A. B. Trentham (Rugby) were two who fared indifferently in the trial game and did not look impressive. Constant came to Lord's with the reputation of being unsound but a hard hitter with ample beef behind his strokes. We could credit that assessment. D. C. Haywood also achieved little. Lord's was too much for him, though late in a tucked-up innings he let loose a fine straight drive to hint at the qualities which enabled him to play an innings of 137 in one hour and fifty minutes for Nottingham High School. Finally among the batsmen P. G. Carling (Kingston Grammar School) stepped into The Rest side at the last minute when P. A. Baker (Cheltenham) who was clearly one of the year's leading batsmen, was unable to play. Carling, a wicketkeeper, split a finger while fielding. He batted in circumstances which did not help him in both innings, but he shaped nicely and neatly. I personally would have liked to have seen more of him.

Of those who specialised in bowling on this occasion P. R. Goodwin, the wrong foot, fast-medium bowler from Lancing, was again deservedly first choice as opener. Elviss was the only other rated among the specialists to win a place in the final side. Though his success during the four days was not spectacular, he appealed to me more than all the other bowlers. He was an off-spinner with a splendid, strong action, and he looked much better with the bat than the number ten position suggested.

Elviss suffered in the trial game from his field placing, particularly against such a good driver as Daniels. He bowled just as an off-spinner should, his length full to keep the batsman on the front foot, but such bowling requires a fielder at long-on when the pitch is firm and true, and more deep fielders when the ball is biting. When Elviss suffered from the straight and, on occasions, lofted driving of Daniels, he or his captain moved mid-off and mid-on half-way back. Elviss then had the worst of both worlds. There was still no fielder to introduce a serious element of risk when Daniels lifted his drive. And, when he or his partner played the ball along the ground to mid-off or mid-on, they could take an easy single. The modern off-spinner seems willing to have a man near the square leg boundary but reluctant to have a deep fielder straight. This is a tactic which I cannot understand. The bowler keeping a full length should require a deep fielder straight on all types of pitch,

but the man near the square leg boundary becomes important more obviously on a turner.

The remaining bowlers included A. R. G. James, the slowest and highest tosser of the ball I have ever seen. Watching him reminded me of a certain club cricketer who occasionally bowled—almost exclusively when he was himself the captain. On one of his days of captaincy he was disappointed indeed not to land an lbw decision and afterwards tackled the umpire on the subject. "The ball pitched right, didn't it, the batsman's leg was right in front and the ball was going to hit the wicket?" The umpire agreed. "Why didn't you give him out then?" "Because", the umpire stated, "in my opinion the ball would not have hit the wicket hard enough to dislodge a bail." With his lofty flight, the ball rising fifteen feet or more James clearly mesmerised numerous opponents of Uppingham into submission. He could not do the same at Lord's, where Aers made a hearty meal of poor James. J. M. H. Grimsdick, of Merchant Taylors', completes the bowling story, a wee fellow who bowled left-arm spinners. He was inaccurate but clearly looked a good prospect.

Perhaps the most difficult choice for the Schools selectors was that of the stumper. There was not much to choose between R. W. Tolchard (Malvern) and D. W. W. Norris (Harrow). Perhaps Tolchard's batting was the deciding factor, though without it I thought he just had the edge on Norris as a neat wicket-keeper. Had Norris been preferred behind the stumps, the selectors would have had to include Tolchard among their specialist batsmen. His correct style and smooth strokes play in the second innings of the trial game indicated him as one of the summer's best boy batsmen. He should on this showing have occupied a position above number nine, from where he helped Spray to save the Schools from the Services bowlers on the first day of the final match.

Before leaving the events at Lord's mention must be made of the moderate standard of the fielding. We have seen much good fielding in these matches in recent years. We saw little in 1964, and one or two of those engaged in the trial match looked middle aged in their immobility. Whatever else the boys may do or not do, when they come as Schools representatives to Lord's, they must field well. Most other failings may be forgiven, but never bad fielding. However, the standard in some school sides was clearly satisfying. Bolton, who were not beaten in an inter-schools match, report that catching in the match winning class was the feature of their season. The Bolton captain, D. Holdsworth, finished three seasons in the School XI without once being dismissed for a duck. Fielding also helped Cranleigh to an unexpectedly successful season. They began with no old colours but won through because they fielded excellently and were a well knit team in the best sense of the word. Bryanston also began without great expectations, having

only one old colour, and yet emerged with only one defeat in nine matches.

Of the larger schools, who meet the strongest opposition, Tonbridge, Repton and Wellington, who have not figured prominently in recent seasons, had perhaps most reason for satisfaction. Wellington fielded the same side throughout the season. They were unbeaten by another school, and their victims included Eton and Charterhouse, both of whom were strong. Their captain, C. M. St. G. Potter, was perhaps unlucky not to be chosen for Lord's, since he spun out 43 opponents at under 12 runs each. Tonbridge also thrived on spin bowling, winning five inter-school matches and losing only to Christ's Hospital. Harrow's batting was frail, their bowling strong except when it mattered most, against Eton. Marlborough, for whom D. R. Walsh headed both sets of averages, did not lose to another school. Dulwich thrived on strong, aggressive batting. Against Bedford N. J. Cosh and R. D. V. Knight hit 170 for the first wicket. Repton were clearly one of the best sides, winning eight of their first nine matches, and Bradfield lost only once.

K.C.S., Wimbledon, for whom D. R. Owen-Thomas hit three centuries and an aggregate of 642, were unbeaten; Merchant Taylors' gained eleven wins against four losses; Highgate and King's School, Ely, each won nine times. In Scotland Strathallan were unbeaten, and A. J. Fleming made his total of wickets 115 in two seasons. Even in a year when most schools are disappointed by modest records there are invariably some with much to cheer them. This was, however, a season of many drawn matches, and both Haileybury and Rugby drew all their inter-school games. Most of those who did well appeared to succeed because they had good spin bowling. Most of those who did not lamented the lack of such bowling. Spin has tended to be ignored in our first-class cricket of late. The blame for that state of affairs rests on the green-top pitches, which have been all too common and have turned medium-paced hacks into killer bowlers to the exclusion of spinners. Boys follow their elders in games and imitate what they see. Hence the widely felt lack of spinners in the schools. This will doubtless be corrected, to the general benefit of our cricket, if the current attempt to produce fast and closely cut pitches for county matches succeeds and revives the arts of slow bowling. The boys will surely not be slow to be influenced by first-class example.
