



THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN 1968

We English may be trusted to make the most of any opportunity to talk about our weather. Inevitably almost every report from the Schools about their 1968 season began with that subject, with particular reference to the soggy month of May. The schools were then sorely handicapped by loss of early practice, both in the nets and in the middle. Some sides never overcame that handicap; others, to their considerable credit did so, and finished the term with excellent records. One obvious lesson from the wet summer is that we cannot afford to neglect our slow bowling. Many of the unsuccessful teams suffered from lack of spin, and most of the successful ones received important contributions from their slow bowlers.

Inevitably many of the schools suffered from inexperienced batting, which could not attune itself to the soft pitches. Yet at the highest level the batsmen were emphatically better than the bowlers. Indeed those in the representative games at Lord's were collectively much superior to their immediate predecessors of 1967. In all grades of cricket, and seemingly throughout the world, the batting is currently superior to the bowling. Too often the superiority springs from defensive batsmanship. It was all the more heartening, therefore, to find so many eager stroke makers among the leading boy batsmen. There was not one defensively minded player among those chosen to bat against Combined Services.

In that match the boys scored considerably faster than their seniors in the first innings. That performance persuaded the Services against a declaration subsequently. They showed their respect for the Schools batting by leaving them finally to attempt 220 at a rate above 75 an hour. In going for the runs the boys lost, victims of their own virtues. In the long run, however, when their aggression is matched by experience, they will gain more from the sort of enterprising cricket they now play than they can ever lose. W. G. Dover, hard-hitting batsman and off-spin bowler, played on their relative inexperience and proved the match-winner. The early Services batting, somewhat crude, did not offer much instruction for the boys, but the brisk manner in which their opening bowlers got through their overs should have been a valuable lesson in an age of laggard bowlers.

Anyone trying to name the best Schools batsman of the year would have a difficult task. *Eton* claimed that M. J. J. Faber was their best since the war. His record was magnificent, 751 runs, three centuries and an average of 83.44. Those are striking figures in a

wet summer. At Lord's he did not score heavily, but he showed himself to be an eager stroke-maker with a particularly good drive. My fancy was G. D. Barlow, of *Ealing Grammar School*. He looked every inch a cricketer, a fine fielder and splendidly aggressive left-handed batsman. His strokes were beautifully crisp and he was particularly strong on the front foot. The Public Schools XI dismissed him cheaply in the first innings of their match against the English Schools Cricket Association. In the second they suffered severely from the weight of his stroke play and splendid running between wickets while he scored 72 in seventy minutes.

Barlow's opening partner in both matches was R. G. Lumb (*Mexborough Grammar School*), a tall Yorkshireman, straight and correct on most occasions though addicted, like so many today, to the sweep. His strength lay on the leg side, for his off-side strokes were struck too gently to be effective. Nonetheless he looked a thoroughly good batsman. Lord's brought particular success to another uninhibited stroke player, J. H. Mytton of *Bedford*. In five innings his lowest score was 24, and against the Services his 59 not out was scored at nearly one a minute. He had a wide range of strokes and the confidence to play them. M. T. Barford (*Eastbourne*) was one more with scant respect for bowlers. He set off with three cracking fours against the Services before neglecting to get to the line of the ball when driving at Dover's off break.

As usual the Schools were rich in all-rounders, who could be regarded as specialists in either branch. Chief among them was P. D. Johnson of *Nottingham High School*, for whom he had a truly tremendous season. It brought him 1,061 runs, average 70.7, and 75 wickets at a cost of merely 8.9 each. For the previous highest scorer and wicket-taker at the school it is necessary to go back more than half a century. The previous best aggregate of runs by a Nottingham H.S. batsman was 637 in 1911, and the best bowling performance before Johnson was 64 wickets in 1897. Moreover his 1968 bag took his total of wickets for the first XI to 382. Not surprisingly Nottingham won 10 of their 19 matches, losing only two, and no other school in our list gained so many victories. If Johnson was tiring when he came to Lord's, it could not be regarded as surprising. He did not score heavily, but he did enough to reveal the neatness and correctness of his batting method, and greater use might have been made of his leg-break bowling.

The Schools were captained by another all-rounder, H. T. Tunnicliffe, who achieved more in his secondary role as a bowler than with the bat, which had given him an average of 50 in a *Malvern* side whose brittle batting leaned heavily on him and the 14-year-old I. N. Johnson. Nevertheless, he showed us familiarity with the off drive common to the best Malvernian batsmen.

Those booked to figure in the main attack found themselves batting low in the representative Schools side. Thus A. P. Webster was number eight, although his 590 for *Harrow* put him among the leading scorers of the year at the larger schools playing against the toughest opposition. We accordingly saw more of his off-break bowling, which was steady and useful and may become more than useful when he learns to deliver the ball with more snap. Ninth in the order was J. C. Richardson, the captain and leading batsman for the successful *St. Peter's* side. He was not out in four out of five innings at Lord's. Since he had averaged 42 for *St. Peter's*, that was not surprising when he had to bat so low. The side was completed by two bowlers of pace from the English Schools Cricket Association, whose bowling was clearly superior to that of the Public Schools. J. R. Gray (*Woodland*) was a left-hander with a fair action, a trifle laboured perhaps, and abundant stamina. J. Spencer from *Brighton, Hove and Sussex G.S.*, tall and strongly built, had the better action and was more accurate. He kept the ball well up to the batsman at attacking length and looked an excellent prospect.

If a third bowler of pace had been required for the final Schools XI, the position would probably have been filled by the first change E.S.C.A. bowler, M. N. Field of *Bablake*, in preference to M. R. S. Nevin (*Winchester*), who was the most likely opener in the attack of the Public Schools side. In the event the job was done by Tunnicliffe, whose confidence or bluff carried him through successfully. A slow-medium boy bowler who starts with two slips, a gully, a silly mid-off and two short leg fielders, shows surprising contempt for adult opponents. His trust was in fact not misplaced against the early Services batsmen in the first innings. That such a team should submit to being crowded by fielders when opposed by schoolboy bowling was unexpected and, as an example of the modern spirit in the adult game, disturbing. In the second innings the boys paid the price of their umbrella field. Off the first 13 balls six fours were scored, but all came behind the wicket.

I am not an advocate of the umbrella field as a regular policy in any class of game, and least of all in boys' cricket. When eight of the nine fielders are clustered round the wicket, one or two of them are placed where close catches look highly improbable. Those fielders would be more usefully employed ensuring that snicks which penetrate the close field score ones instead of fours, thus helping to make the batsman really work for his start. A player who races into double figures in a couple of overs or so feels on top of the world, brimful of confidence, even if all his scoring strokes have been edged. Equally the bowler who, through no fault of his own, is edged for three quick fours is rattled. The umbrella field is usually bad psychology.

Those who won the selection for the representative match had to earn their positions against strong rivals. In the E.S.C.A. team A. Hill (*New Mills G.S.*) must have pressed Webster particularly hard for the off-spinner's position. Strong candidates could also have been found among those who did not come to Lord's. There were excellent reports of P. H. Edmonds, an outstanding all-rounder in a *Cranbrook* side of exceptional all-round strength. They won nine of the ten matches played, three being abandoned, and were beaten only by M.C.C. Edmonds contributed 471 runs, averaging 67, and 39 wickets at fewer than 10 runs each.

Despite the adverse weather the standard of cricket played by the leading boys was good. I do not remember seeing such a high proportion of school batsmen playing the hook stroke so well. Slow pitches doubtless gave them ample opportunity to practise the stroke. The fielding generally was excellent on the ground. The catching was not so sure. Here a word might be said about a common fault. One of the boys, who shall remain anonymous, missed a catch against the Services. He then stood, airing his surprise and pondering on how such an event could happen, while the batsmen took another run. Many fielders are prone to amble casually after the ball, when they have misfielded, instead of racing to cut the cost of their mistake. It is absurd to aggravate the offence in such a way.

If no other school matched the magnificent record of Cranbrook, nor the number of wins gained by Johnson's Nottingham side, there were numerous good performances. *Bradford Grammar School*, on the strength of powerful bowling and fine fielding, won nine of 11 matches and lost only once. Both J. G. Driver and D. Moulds took more than 30 wickets at fewer than 5 runs each. *King's, Ely*, for whom B. J. D'Hooghe took eight for 2 against Kimbolton, had eight victories. *Emanuel*, who enjoyed their best season for several years, had seven wins to set against two defeats. They had a powerful batting side with virtually no tail, and their captain, P. Needham, was a splendidly successful all-rounder. In a year when many games were inevitably left drawn, some schools came through unbeaten, including *St. Dunstan's* for the first time since records were first kept 70 years ago and *St. Edward's, Oxford*, for the second year running. *Eastbourne, Newcastle R.G.S., Rossall, Sebright* and *George Heriot's* were unbeaten teams. D. N. West and R. P. C. Dickson made 166 for Eastbourne's first wicket against M.C.C.

Clearly the most exciting side was *Charterhouse*, an aggressive team with a preponderance of batsmen with an instinctive urge to hit the ball hard, high-class fielding and admirable spin bowling. They consistently scored faster than their opponents, and they beat

the Old Carthusians off the last ball of the match by hitting 60 in the final twenty-five minutes. Their leading scorer, R. E. W. Wild, contributed to the exciting defeat of *Eton* by making 81 in seventy minutes.

For the third year running *Dulwich* were unbeaten by a school side. They lost only to *Surrey Colts* and were one of the strongest sides. Their batting, headed by B. B. Henfrey-Smith, was sound, and the opening bowler, R. J. D. Linnecar, who took 38 wickets, was a match-winning asset. *Harrow*, too, had a fine side and an excellent record, with victories against *Eton*, *Malvern* and *Haileybury* and draws with *Winchester* and *Charterhouse*. The batting of *Webster*, 590 runs, the bowling of I. Coomeraswamy, *Webster* and S. G. Holland and splendid fielding were the main ingredients of their success. *Winchester*, who were at their best in June, were much the same with their captain, J. M. Bebb making 505 runs, and Nevin, A. N. G. McLean and the off spinner A. S. G. Thompson forming a strong attack. Though *Rugby's* batting relied overmuch on J. H. C. Austin, who averaged over 48 against other schools, they won four inter-school matches and their defeat by *Clifton* came in the last minute. *Clifton's* record was otherwise undistinguished, and for that they could blame batsmen who did not score fast enough.

Millfield were once more among the most successful sides. Their strong bowling brought six wins, and they lost only to *M.C.C. Wellington College's* record was similar, to which the opening bowlers, H. J. D. Ricketts and R. F. Fawcett, contributed greatly. *King's College School, Wimbledon*, went through a third season unbeaten by another school. In the north *Pocklington's* similar three-year run ended in 1968, for they were overcome by *Manchester G.S.* and *Nottingham H.S.* Nevertheless C. Aldred repeated his personal batting success of 1967 by scoring 546. *St. Peter's* were as usual a powerful force in the north with an admirably balanced side. Nine batsmen scored more than 100 runs, four bowlers averaged under 16, and six matches were won. *Sedbergh* also won six times. A school only twelve years old, *Milton Abbey*, whose averages appear here for the first time, had a success story, eight wins and only one defeat, their batting being headed by P. R. C. Pease with an average of 55. *Wycliffe* splendidly won seven of their eight inter-school matches.

Eton went through the season without a single win, despite the batting of Faber and the excellent off-break bowling of J. R. T. Barclay, who at the age of 14 took 19 wickets. *Eton* were in good company. *Cheltenham*, *Cranleigh*, *St. Paul's*, *Wellingborough* and *Ellesmere* were others without a win in this season of much interference by the weather. *Plymouth* had no fewer than ten matches abandoned, *Repton*, *Stamford* and *Manchester G.S.* eight each.

Perhaps the most remarkable individual performance was that of P. G. R. Williamson, the captain of *Reed's School*. He bowled his left-arm spinners unchanged throughout the school's 11 matches, a total of 252 overs, which brought him 57 wickets at 8.5. Several boys headed both batting and bowling averages. C. J. C. Rowe of *King's, Canterbury*, did so for the second year running. S. A. Murrills headed both lists at *The Leys*, his batting average 62.4, D. R. Simmons at *Perse*, for whom he took 57 wickets at little more than 10 runs each, J. A. Steward at *Gresham's* and S. C. Corlett at *Worksop*. Corlett and Murrills won trials at *Lord's*, and Murrills was one of the season's successful leg-break bowlers in company with Johnson. Another was B. Mayes, the *Ipswich* captain, who also headed his team's batsmen with 469 runs.

This was a good year for wicket-keepers. At *Canford* R. G. Wright had 25 victims in 12 matches. *Canford*, who won six times, also had a highly successful dual-role bowler, M. A. Hamilton-Martin, who alternated between fast left-arm and slow spin, and took 42 wickets with an average of only 6.45. Numerous other outstanding performances merit mention. There were the centuries in each innings scored by D. G. Wheatley for *Lord Wandsworth College* against the old boys. J. C. Poore contributed three centuries and an aggregate of 672 towards *Oundle's* encouraging season. R. J. Walton hit a hundred before lunch for *Haileybury* against *Cheltenham* at *Lord's*, and P. S. Mackie made the first century for *Haberdashers' Aske's* since the war. S. H. Courtney scored 700 runs and S. A. Hatteea took 60 wickets for *City of London School*. *Chigwell's* left-arm spinner, R. J. Wiggs, took 45 wickets at 10.86. At *Uppingham* W. R. Ward's aggregate of 708 has only once been exceeded, and that as long ago as 1893 by C. E. M. Milton. Yet spin-bowling weakness held *Uppingham* back, and they won merely once. By contrast *Shrewsbury* had a much improved record, helped by the spin of P. S. Bryan and C. Sultan, the leading wicket-takers.

In Scotland the strongest schools appear to have been *Fettes* and *Loretto*. *Fettes* had a well-balanced side and did not lose until their final match, in which *Loretto* conquered them. *Loretto*, who were beaten only by *Edinburgh University*, owed much to their captain, K. D. M. Wilson. He averaged almost 50 with the bat and behind the wicket had 27 wickets in 11 games, which excelled the record of Wright at *Canford*.

During recent years *Marlborough* have had a series of sons of famous Test cricketers in their side. S. C. Griffith's son was followed by F. R. Brown's son. Now in 1968 they had P. M. D. Compton, son of Denis. He headed the batting averages with 29.88, but in general *Marlborough's* batting was not strong enough to give them much success, and three inter-school matches were lost.

TWENTY-ONE YEARS OF PROGRESS

On June 21, 1948 the representatives of twelve Schools' County Associations met at Twickenham to discuss the possibility of forming an English Association. They decided to do so. In the following season the first matches were played: a junior match at Denton between the North and South and a two-day match for the Senior boys at Dean Park, Bournemouth, against the Welsh Schools. Ken Taylor, subsequently of Yorkshire, played in the first match, and Michael Barnard, later of Hampshire in the second. These were the first of the very many E.S.C.A. boys, who were later to play for their County Clubs and a number, such as David Brown, Alan Knott, Colin Milburn and Derek Underwood for their country.

The early years were very difficult, with the many financial problems of the then small voluntary organisation in its struggle for recognition, both officially and in areas where schools' cricket was inadequately covered and organised. In 1950, an E.S.C.A. team played at Lord's for the first time—against the M.C.C. Young Professionals. In 1951 Harry Altham became the first President and by his inspiration encouraged further progress.

In 1957 the Midlands raised a side for the first time and two years later Mike Griffith captained at Edgbaston the first Public School side to play the Association's Junior team; a continuing series of matches which has produced much good cricket.

From the first the Association has realised the importance of first class coaching, both for masters and for the more promising schoolboy cricketers. In 1951 the *News Chronicle* agreed to give coaching to 19 selected boys, five of whom subsequently played first-class cricket. In 1952 the first residential coaching course was held at Lilleshall for 36 selected boys with Harry Altham as its presiding genius. In more recent years the continuance of this course has been helped by grants from the M.C.C. Youth Cricket Association. This has enabled the Association to envisage a second course, which, with so many disappointed applicants each year, became an increasing necessity. This began at Fortescue House in 1955 and continued with some breaks till 1966. It has now been transferred to the Crystal Palace National Centre, where some 80 boys are coached annually.

As the programme has extended so has the Association enlarged until by 1968 every County in England, including even Huntingdon, Hereford and Rutland, has a Schools' County Association.

To mark its twenty-first season E.S.C.A. are staging a five-day Junior Festival at Lincoln School, arranged by their Chairman, the Rev. R. C. H. Woodward, himself a former Head Boy of the School.

The E.S.C.A. Senior team will play two-day matches against the Public Schools at Lord's, Welsh Schools at Liverpool, Scottish Cricket Union at Edinburgh, and C. R. M. Atkinson's XI at Millfield. In addition there will be a one-day game against the Canadian Touring side at Ilford.—C. R. Hansford.
