



THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN 1970

Many schools had a much more cheerful story to tell about their cricket in 1970 than in the rainy season of 1969. Abandoned games were comparatively rare, and the fine weather allowed boys to develop confidence on dry pitches. We should feel the benefit of this summer in the following year or two, for several sides were unusually young. They should have gained much from the dry ground cricket of 1970 and now become all the more formidable. It is important that they should, for the evidence of recent years indicates that the standard of British schoolboy cricket is not as good as it might be. Touring sides of youngsters from India, South Africa and West Indies have shown their superiority. In two games at Lord's against overseas opposition the representative schools side have been soundly beaten, by India in 1967 and West Indies in 1970.

It may be argued that boys from the warmer climates develop more quickly than those who grow up in Britain. Against that must be set the vastly greater population of the British schools and their generally superior facilities for bringing on their games players. The West Indies Young Cricketers who played at Lord's were not all still schoolboys, but their ages were the same as those of their opponents. It was, in fact, a fair test of junior cricket in Britain and the West Indies. And the latter proved vastly superior in all branches.

They gave a strong impression of being the more natural players, and their batsmen were more obviously conscious that the bat and not the pad is the main weapon. They looked indeed a thorough team with strong and aggressive batsmen and an admirably balanced attack, which was well supported in the field. The left-arm googly bowling of B. Sahadeo and the medium-paced spin of L. A. Gomes, who turned the ball from the off and ran it away towards his slips, were too much for their opponents.

The home players, who would have been walloped well before tea but for a sterling innings of attack by D. L. Bairstow (*Hanson G.S.*), the young Yorkshire first-team wicket-keeper, generally compared badly with them. They looked more like the products of sausage-machine coaching, who have spent too long watching county players on television, from whom they have absorbed more of the bad than the good habits. The latter included a break for

drinks in mid-afternoon on a mild day, when they had spent less than an hour in the field. The worst habit of all concerned pad play. This was most marked in the case of A. K. C. Jones of *Solithull*, who has joined the Warwickshire staff. He is an obviously gifted young batsman with plenty of good looking strokes, particularly on the off side, but his defence is based largely on the use of his left pad. The new experimental lbw law was brought in to counter such tactics. It was disturbing to see them being used, and used to excess, by such a young cricketer, particularly as he is a good enough player to trust his bat.

The experimental law allows a batsman to be given out to a ball pitched outside the off stump, if he makes no genuine attempt to play the ball with his bat. What constitutes a genuine attempt? I felt that the umpires at Lord's were generous in regarding some of the moves Jones made to the ball just outside the off stump as genuine. On such occasions he thrust his left leg in front of the ball, so that it could not get through to the wicket, and made a pass with the bat outside his pad. That was surely not a genuine attempt, for it made sure that the bat had no possible chance of making contact with the ball. I hope Jones will come to realise that his future lies in making full use of his ability with the bat. His average of nearly 60 for *Solithull*, and his 53 for the English Schools C.A. at Lord's gave ample evidence of that ability. For 13 overs in that 53 he remained scoreless, after which his off-side stroke play was as good as anything seen from the batsmen in that game.

He was high among the most gifted batsmen seen at Lord's, outside the West Indies ranks. Far more exciting, however, was the play of the left-handed R. P. Brown (*Marlborough*), the son of F. R. Brown. There may be flaws in his play. He may even be too adventurous, though I question if that is possible in a young cricketer. But he certainly knows the purpose of a bat. Like his father he believes in hitting the ball with it emphatically. His play at the start of the match against the West Indies Y.C. gave no hint of the catastrophes that were to befall the home side subsequently. Brown, whose hooking was particularly exciting, so walloped the bowling of S. Matthews, a decidedly fast bowler who has represented Guyana in the Shell Shield, that 25 were hit off him in three overs. Brown's approach to the job of batting was splendidly uncomplicated. But why must he handicap himself by sporting his hair so long? A hair net might have been more useful to him than his cap, which perched on top of the shrub without any permanence. Every time he ran he had to pluck it from his head and carry it. On occasions it fell off as he played a stroke. One of these days, perhaps on an occasion of considerable importance to him, it will

fall on the stumps, and he will be out hit wicket. Such luxuriant growth of hair is as much a handicap to a cricketer as long finger nails.

Alas, apart from Brown's innings the early batsmen did little to cause enthusiasm. Jones and J. L. Kuiper (*Rugby*) made small contributions, after which the side slumped from 67 at the fall of the second wicket to 97 for nine. Bairstow by then was batting in the uninhibited manner of Brown, driving loftily and hooking from good footwork, and J. M. H. Graham-Brown of *Sevenoaks* helped him to add 44 for the last wicket. Defeat by six wickets was accordingly less severe than it might have been.

The home players should perhaps, in the circumstances, be judged by their own standards rather than those of the West Indies. The schoolboy cricketer of the year was undoubtedly Bairstow. That he batted as low as number nine at Lord's was doubtless due only to the fact that he was the wicket-keeper. In the latter capacity he was quite exceptional for an English schoolboy, and I rejoiced to see him standing up to bowlers of some pace. He was definitely a stumper rather than the long-stop who has become so familiar to us. After the shine was off the new ball he not only stood up to the medium quick bowling of Graham-Brown but took it perfectly. Earlier in the season I listened to someone expounding the theory that cricket had become such that no longer could a schoolboy hope to go straight into the county game. Bairstow disproved that theory. If the schools raise their cricketing sights higher, others may also do so.

On paper the representative side was powerful indeed. Had it not been for the West Indies Y.C., we should have confidently claimed 1970 as a vintage year for batsmen and bowlers. Not the fielding, however. This was surprisingly indifferent at Lord's in a season when numerous individual schools attributed much of their success to fine fielding and catching. All-rounders were plentiful. C. J. C. Rowe, who bowled a variety of styles for *King's*, *Canterbury*, J. R. T. Barclay, the *Eton* captain, N. E. J. Pocock of *Shrewsbury*, Brown, and, indeed, most of those who bowled. P. Booth of *Whitcliffe Mount*, the fastest of the bowlers, batted number ten for the E.S.C.A. against the Public Schools but looked good enough to hold a place among the reputable batsmen.

Barclay had a personal triumph in that game, when he took all the nine E.S.C.A. wickets that fell. A declaration then, when he had the once-in-a-lifetime chance of taking all 10 wickets on the headquarters ground of world cricket, was somewhat unchivalrous. Barclay was a really good schoolboy off-spinner, the best I think I have seen since Marljar was at Harrow. He had a good sideways

action with a lively body movement, and he bowled his overs without waste of time. He was full value for his nine for 57 in 28 overs, and he also looked good against the West Indies. On the whole the actions of the bowlers, quick and slow alike, were better than many we have seen in the representative games in recent years. There were few open-chesters, and none in the final side, though there was one, Brown, who bowled leg-breaks with a very curious action. His left arm was so far back that he delivered the ball from behind his left ear.

Rowe, who captained the Schools side, was clearly a cricketer of many parts who should make a mark in adult cricket. In the past two years he made nearly 1,000 runs and exceeded 100 wickets for his school. Pocock came to Lord's no less highly recommended, for in addition to taking 29 wickets for Shrewsbury he ran a batting average of 120. I cannot recall such a high school average. It did, however, owe much to eight not-out innings in 15, and I question if this was such a fine Shrewsbury performance as that of D. N. Moore in 1929. Moore had 14 innings, of which ten were completed, and made 1,038 against Pocock's 842. Moore also headed the Shrewsbury bowlers with 35 wickets at 12.25 each. Pocock disappointingly failed against the West Indies Y.C. He was bowled while trying to cut an off-break from Gomes, an indiscretion doubtless induced by the confidence which comes from making so many runs.

Of the specialist batsmen too little was seen at Lord's of J. C. Foat, who had made 606 runs for *Millfield*, and not much more of J. L. Kuiper, whose total for Rugby was 700. Kuiper, however, batted long enough to explain those school runs. His method was sound and his stroke making crisp. G. McMeekin (*Millom G.S.*) played a considerable innings for the E.S.C.A. Indeed, only he and, subsequently, Booth held up Barclay once he had removed Jones. McMeekin was a burly left-handed batsman who hit weightily to leg, a trifle uncultured maybe, but a batsman with the right attitude. One cricketer who had little chance at Lord's because the second day of the Public Schools v. E.S.C.A. game was washed out was I. N. Johnson, the *Malvern* all-rounder from the Bahamas, who had taken 48 wickets for a generally unsuccessful school side with left-arm spin.

Four schools, who were both unbeaten and won a large number of matches, had particular reason to rejoice in 1970. They were *St. Paul's*, *King's Canterbury*, *Millfield* and *Haber-dashers' Aske's*. *St. Paul's* won 11 times during their most successful season ever. This was their first unbeaten side. They owed much to the high standard of their fielding and the captaincy of H. J.

Masters, who also headed the batsmen by scoring 593 runs. King's had 10 wins, and now they have had a run of 34 matches without defeat. They had three splendid all-rounders, Rowe, B. R. Weedon and C. B. Hamblin. In 16 matches the three accounted for 2,281 runs and 118 wickets. Weedon's contribution was the greatest. He made four centuries, totalled 1,084 and took 48 wickets with his leg-breaks. His batting average was close to 100. Fast scoring opened the way for their numerous victories, for they averaged 3.8 runs an over.

Millfield won 9 out of 17 matches. Foat and W. J. le Breton were a highly successful opening pair, who three times passed 100 together and twice passed 50 in seven partnerships. Another batting achievement was S. R. L. Long's century in fifty-seven minutes to beat the Oxford University Authentics. D. A. Gravenev was the leading bowler, his 44 wickets costing merely 10.88 each. Haberdashers' Aske's, whose captain, L. O. Hughes, made 568 runs and took 39 wickets, won nine and drew nine.

Bloxham, unbeaten for the second year running, had seven wins, and other unbeaten sides were *Lancaster Royal G.S.* and *Warwick*, while for the third year running *Sherborne* and *Merchiston* were unbeaten by a school side. Several others reported their best ever season or best for many years. *Ampleforth* claimed the best XI they have ever had, a side of exceptional fielding who won seven inter-school games, losing only to Uppingham. Ironically that was the latter's only win of the year. Against Bootham, W. M. Reichwald, a highly successful all-rounder and the *Ampleforth* captain, and R. J. Twohig, shared a stand of 215 against Bootham. *Douai* with 11 wins to set against two defeats had their most successful season, and G. Bramall's 504 runs were a school record. Ten wins in the term constituted a record for *Sebright*, and *King Edward VI*, *Stourbridge*, *Monkton Combe* and *Sevenoaks* were among those who have to go back many years to find a side that did so well, and *Reed's* at Cobham, who lost only to M.C.C., have never fared better.

Shrewsbury with the redoubtable Pocock were highly successful, unbeaten by any other school and trouncing Rugby by eight wickets. *Haileybury*, who lost only once, were one of the best teams. They had three batsmen who made more than 450 runs and two bowlers who together took more than 100 wickets at low cost. *Eastbourne* beat six school sides. Their success was based on three left-handed players, bowlers I. R. Davidson and P. R. Philcox and batsman P. J. D. Pierrepont, who averaged almost 50. *Eton*, who beat Charterhouse, Winchester, Marlborough—the latter's only loss—and Harrow, had an individual record to report. No other batsman has scored as many runs for the College as the 897 of Barclay.

The leading Scottish school appears to have been *Fettes* in their Centenary Year. A well balanced side had eight wins and only one defeat. They had two excellent all-rounders, the captain R. A. B. Reid and S. R. G. Pratt, who headed both sets of averages.

Mid-term exams accounted for the only defeat of *Stockport G.S.*, for they lost to the University of Lancaster with a much weakened team. In the words of their cricket master they had to face "a more experienced side (and with even longer hair)". Exams at that time are more than a nuisance to the cricketers, but the trend towards staging festivals and tours after term can compensate for the disruption. Ample cricket is certainly played. *Emanuel* and *Nottingham H.S.* each played 27 matches in 1970.

A remarkable match was the tie between *Bedford* and the *Buccaneers*, when the last four wickets fell with the scores level. *Berkhamsted* had a stirring win against Magdalen College School by eight wickets as the result of an unfinished stand of 147 in 76 minutes by D. R. J. Arnold and P. B. Gibbs. In similar style *St. Edward's, Oxford*, hit 148 for two in ninety minutes against *Bradfield* and P. M. Davies clouted 129 of them. One of the largest stands of the school season was 175 for the first *Allhallows* wicket against their Old Boys by A. B. Mason and M. W. B. McCulloch. *Brighton's* term was made memorable by the feat of C. J. Terleski, who scored four successive centuries. Another exhilarating finish was provided by *Queen Elizabeth G.S., Wakefield*, to beat *Nottingham H.S.*, for an unbroken fifth-wicket stand put on 91 in twenty-five minutes. Perhaps the most remarkable individual performance was that of the wicket-keeper batsman J. L. Rose. When *St. John's, Leatherhead*, were dismissed for 108 by Epsom, he made 95, and six of the other runs were extras. In the full season Rose made 815. Another stumper-batsman of exceptional promise was P. F. Pennock at the age of 15. He averaged over 30 with the bat and behind the stumps had 23 victims for *St. George's, Weybridge*. On a final individual note, R. G. G. Carr made 738 with an average of 82 for *Stowe*. His efforts were so indifferently supported, however, the next batsman failing to average 20, that *Stowe* won only one of their 12 games.

What happens in the county game invariably influences the lower reaches of cricket. During 1970 *Bishop's Stortford* experimented with limited-over matches. Their second team had five in which the limit was 40 overs each side. It is to be hoped the idea does not spread further, for genuine cricketers cannot be developed in the helter-skelter of those unreal frolics. They may be fun, they may be highly entertaining, but they are not cricket. They are certainly not for schoolboys except perhaps as a very occasional light relief.

ETON v. HARROW

At Harrow, July 9, 10. Eton won by 97 runs with six minutes to spare. It was the first occasion in peace-time since 1805 that this oldest of all fixture was not played at Lord's. The ground was reserved for Middlesex in case they needed it for a Gillette Cup tie, but they had already been knocked out of the competition. Eton deserved their victory, but until after tea on the first day the struggle was even; then quite surprisingly the last six Harrow wickets went down in a high wind in forty minutes for 29 runs, giving Eton a lead of 14.

Wyndham, six feet four inches, twice destroyed the Harrow batting with his good length medium bowling. He finished with 10 wickets for 83, having previously claimed 11 Winchester victims. Mitchell also bowled splendidly for Harrow. His six for 64 gained mainly with medium inswing followed eleven against Eton the previous year. Moreover, this fine effort at the beginning of the match, gave Harrow a real chance, but apart from Lepp and Needham they were badly let down by their batsmen. Consistent and sound batting on the second day enabled Eton to leave their rivals 213 to win at 76 an hour, a task they never looked like accomplishing, although they fought bravely to the very end.

WEST INDIES YOUNGSTERS VISIT ENGLAND

A team of West Indies young cricketers toured England during July and August under the management of Wes Hall, the Test player. The tour was sponsored by the U.K. Committee of the Sir Frank Worrell Memorial Fund and a return visit by a team of England young cricketers is being arranged for the 1971-72 Christmas holidays.

The West Indies Board of Control staged trials in Guyana before sending their first young side abroad. In a programme of 16 fixtures, one at Lancaster against Lancashire was abandoned. Nine victories were gained over: Stowe School Past and Present, Wellington College P. & P., Eton Ramblers, National Association of Youth Clubs at Trent Bridge, Welsh Schools, Somerset and Gloucestershire Young Cricketers, English Schools Cricket Association at The Oval, England Young Cricketers at Lord's, and London Schools Cricket Association. Six games left drawn were: Leys School P. & P., Sherborne P. & P., Millfield School, Warwickshire and Staffordshire Young Cricketers, Surrey and Kent Young Cricketers, and The Duke of Norfolk's XI.

It was an arduous tour, 27 of the 38 days being devoted to cricket and at an average age of 18 the West Indies player was generally more mature as a cricketer than his English counterpart. The batsmen, of whom R. Gabriel (*Trinidad*), K. Venkersammy (*Guyana*), L. Gomes (*Trinidad*), D. Murray (*Barbados*) and D. Ramkisson (*Trinidad*), the captain, were most prominent, were true disciples of Sobers and believed in hitting the ball. The team had virtually no tail. The main attack comprised two fast bowlers: W. Bourne (*Barbados*) and S. Matthews (*Guyana*) and two talented spinners in B. Sahadeo (*Trinidad*) who proved perplexing with his mixture of left-handed googlies and chinamen, and N. Nanan (*Trinidad*) a brilliant all-rounder, superb cover point and genuine leg-break bowler. D. Murray, the vice-captain, was also a splendid wicket-keeper.

The organisers were grateful to Messrs. Tate and Lyle for providing transport throughout the tour and to B.O.A.C.
