



SCHOOLS CRICKET IN 1979

Despite an uncertain start to their season, owing to the apparent shyness of summer, the schools overcame inclement conditions to return a number of encouraging performances. For the English Schools selectors, putting together a balanced side was further complicated by the Youth Tournament in Canada, which coincided with the representative programme and required some schools players. In the event, then, it was fortunate for the English Schools that they could call on a strong nucleus of players from the 1978 team and could appreciate the co-operation of the first-class counties, to whom a number of their players were committed.

The overall standard of the representative players was the highest for some years, but even more satisfying was the team spirit and general attitude both on and off the field. These brought unsolicited praise from many quarters and were due, in no small way, to the captaincy and all-round leadership of Nigel Felton (Kent and Millfield). Captain of the England Young Cricketers in Australia the previous winter and Schweppes Schoolboy of the Year in 1978, he had in his 1979 schools teams four fellow tourists – A. Arundell (Yorkshire), K. James (Middlesex), G. J. Lord (Warwick School and Warwickshire) and S. Dennis (Yorkshire). Others from 1978 were S. J. G. Doggart (Hampshire and Winchester), S. Hinks (Kent) and N. Weightman (Nottinghamshire), while in J. Stanworth (Lancashire) the side had a wicket-keeper of much promise.

Felton enjoyed a most successful season, topping 1,000 runs in school and representative matches. T. J. Boon (Yorkshire), with 353 runs and seventeen wickets, was in tremendous form, while Lord, with his slow left-arm spin, G. Hall (Avon), James, medium-pace, and N. Mallender (Yorkshire), fast-medium, gave the schools a nicely balanced attack.

Following the matches at Eastbourne, in which The Rest beat HMC Southern Schools off the last ball of the match and HMC Schools drew with the ESCA, the MCC Schools side for Lord's was virtually the English Schools XI. Crocker (Winchester), who took five for 55 against The Rest, was brought in to replace the injured Dennis. Highlights of the match at The Saffrons were 80 not out and 67 by R. J. Leiper (Chigwell) and Doggart respectively for HMC Schools, half-centuries by A. Settle and Boon for the ESCA, and the left-arm spin of Lord, with three HMC wickets in each innings.

At Lord's, slow batting in both innings by the National Association of Young Cricketers prevented them gaining a victory over the MCC Schools. Lord took five for 43 in 25 overs as the NAYC spent 85 overs compiling 172 for eight. The early Schools batting was torn apart by the pace of Hughes (Middlesex) and Ellison, the former Tonbridge captain (Kent), and from 12 for five they were rescued by Lord and Leiper before being dismissed for 106. NAYC declared their second innings at 185 for three, leaving the MCC Schools an unrealistic target of 252 in just under three hours. With Felton resisting solidly for 35, and Weightman enlivening the closing stages with an unbeaten 50, the Schools looked much happier than in their first innings and a comfortable draw was achieved.

For the limited-overs match against Combined Services, Felton, as captain, Boon, Leiper, Lord and Stanworth were selected for the NCA Young Cricketers XI, with Weightman as twelfth man. Felton (74) and Boon (57) made the major batting contributions as the Young Cricketers, chasing a total of 197 for nine, won by six wickets.

The following schools were unbeaten in all matches, though in some instances the number of drawn matches was equal to or higher than those won. This, however, does not apply to **Trinity School, Croydon**, who enjoyed their best season on record with 18 of their 25 matches won. Against other schools, their record was 13 wins and 4 drawn. Success was built around the prolific opening partnership of R. K. Steadman, whose 1,084 runs were a school record, and J. T. Woodman – three times they put on a hundred for the first wicket and on a further eight occasions topped fifty. Between them they scored five centuries. Bowling honours went to the captain, I. J. Roberts, who led the side for the second season with enthusiasm, skill and knowledge. Two outstanding performances marked his season – nine for 35 and ten for 15, the latter the best analysis for a Trinity bowler. He was well supported by the left-arm spin of N. Rollings. **Bablake, Coventry**, also enjoyed their most successful season, winning all eleven matches against other schools and never losing more than six wickets in an innings. Star of the side was the left-handed opener M. I. N. Eames, whose 921 runs included 109 against Solihull in the final of the Birmingham and Warwickshire Senior Schools knockout.

Milton Abbey were unbeaten for the second time in three years and recorded several comfortable victories against schools. With the batting and bowling averages being headed by fourth formers R. Clive and J. M. D. Boswell (right-arm medium-fast), prospects for the future look bright. **Berkhamsted** suffered, like most, from the early-season weather, and their captain's lack of luck with the call meant they were often put in to bat. The batting was in the capable hands of the captain, E. P. Neal, and the fifteen-year-old B. G. Evans, from whom many more runs are expected. Relieving the Colts of their opening attack – left-arter F. H. Ramsahoye and R. M. Hudson – gave the bowling a more settled look, and with P. J. Allen and M. J. Parsons available again this season, the school will be hoping those draws against schools will become wins. In 1979, only Magdalen College School were beaten. **Haberdashers' Aske's, Elstree** completed a third unbeaten season against schools opposition and remained unbeaten in all matches, despite often chasing large totals against the clock. Openers N. R. W. Colverd and R. G. Price gave them many good starts and were well supported by C. R. Churchman and the left-handed M. J. Bailey. The captain, M. S. Weston, led a useful opening attack with P. D. Kenward.

Birkenhead's unbeaten record owed much to the Varey twins. D. W. Varey, the captain, overcame a hesitant start in wet conditions to produce a number of fine innings, while his brother batted well and bowled magnificently. Spells of eight for 10 v King William's, Isle of Man, and six for 14 v Rydal were match-winning contributions. Another individual match-winning feat came from wicket-keeper A. G. Davies, who batted throughout the innings against King's, Macclesfield. **Christ College, Brecon** lost almost a third of their fixtures yet still had their best season for many years. Sound starts were provided by A. L. G. Jones and P. M. Davies, the captain, ably supported by R. de R. Morgan. Against Carmarthen Wanderers, Davies hit a hundred (108) in 62 minutes while his team-mates could muster only 36 runs from the bat. The bowling was built around the right-arm seam of D. M. A. Evans, who took six wickets in an innings on four occasions, and the promising slow left-arm spin of P. G. Chambers. The fielding of the side was well worthy of commendation.

Queen's College, Taunton won seven matches in an unbeaten season that began with a tie against QEII, Bristol. Victories were obtained over Kingswood, Plymouth College, Truro School, Exeter School, Richard Huish School Taunton, Bristol Cathedral School and Wellington. Success was mainly due to the high standard of fielding coupled with the all-round performances of J. Greenhow and S. Patel. **Cranleigh**, but for the rain and the Lancing last-wicket pair, would have ended the season with a 100 per cent record of wins. They had a very strong side, adventurously and intelligently led by P. H. Prentice, who also topped the batting. The side's strength was in a bowling attack which was never mastered and in which fast bowler A. C. Lax was outstanding.

Harrow's unbeaten season, in which Wellington, St Edward's, Oxford, Charterhouse and Radley were defeated, owed much to a strong batting side with solid openers – M. W. J. Ruffell and M. L. Sealey – and two strong attacking players – W. J. Haggas, the captain, and E. C. Gordon-Lennox. Of the bowlers, only Haggas, right-arm medium-fast, showed any real penetration, and it is perhaps a reflection on the bowling that all six wins were obtained batting second. A post-season tour of Barbados resulted in seven wins and four defeats in limited-overs matches.

Lord William's School, Thame featured wins over MCC, Collyer's School and Oxford School in their five victories. G. N. Plested, an attractive left-hand bat, made several fifties while G. Porter was a distinct prospect as a fast bowler. P. E. Robertson showed skill with his left-arm slows and nerve by scoring all 34 runs in a last-wicket partnership to beat MCC. **Downside**, unbeaten for the second successive year and the third season in four, were stronger in batting than bowling and so had difficulty obtaining positive results. Blundell's and Glenalmond were the only schools beaten. **Ellesmere** never looked like losing any matches, either, and would have secured more wins but for storms. R. F. Smail, captain for the second year, troubled most sides with the new ball; highlight of the batting was I. Owens' century v the XL Club. **Strathallan**, with only two wins in ten matches, looked back on a season when the batting held together without amassing large totals and the bowling, in which left-arm spinners C. A. MacLeod and G. M. Strømme took most wickets, was not strong enough to dismiss the opposition.

Of those schools beaten in only one match, one must offer consolation to **Felsted**. Attempting an unbeaten record for the fifth year running, they lost by five wickets to Clifton

at the Eastbourne Festival after declaring at 231 for three! In term they were unbeaten, winning eight of their nine matches against schools. Outstanding in a strong side was the captain, N. T. Gadsby, who batted attractively, bowled his leg-spinners with great accuracy, and was selected for the NCA tour of Canada. N. C. E. Speakman, hostile and quicker than most, returned figures of seven for 11 v St Paul's and six for 22 when Haileybury were dismissed for 53. R. N. R. Vartan, in addition to his accomplished batting, completed 50 dismissals in two years as the team's wicket-keeper.

Tiffin's only defeat in an outstanding season of ten wins was to a strong MCC side captained by M. J. Stewart and containing Lynch and Wilson of Surrey. N. M. and A. J. Stewart, the Surrey manager's sons, played significant roles in the successes, while the outstanding player was all-rounder M. A. Feltham. His 504 runs included two hundreds and three fifties, and whether bowling fast-medium or off-spin was always threatening. N. M. Stewart, in his second year as captain, toured Canada with the NCA, and six of the side played representative cricket for Surrey.

Millfield, too, suffered their only loss at the hands of MCC, and most of the draws resulted from poor weather rather than negative cricket. One of the strongest sides ever to represent the school was led by the Young England captain, Felton, and he had strong batting support from S. T. T. Wilkinson, J. H. N. Wilson, and A. J. H. Dunning. J. D. Curran was the outstanding bowler with his fast-medium away-swingers, and all the bowlers were encouraged by the keen fielding. At **Brentwood**, Mr C. L. Edgson completed a 31-year stint as cricket master by producing a side strong on batting and fielding, but with indifferent bowling. Forest, Chigwell, Abingdon, Alleyne's and Bancroft's were beaten. Strangely, in an aggregate of 3,023 runs, no batsman scored a century. **Warwick** built their excellent record around the all-round achievements of left-handed G. J. Lord, who scored 828 runs in an aggressive manner and captured 55 wickets with craft and subtlety. His fellow-opener G. A. Tedstone gave worthy support, as did all-rounder S. C. Davis and J. Marcus.

Queen Elizabeth GS, Wakefield concluded their fifth season without defeat by a Yorkshire school and were unbeaten in all school matches. The captain, M. L. Varley, played for The Rest against the HMC Southern Schools, and J. S. Young, a colt, played for the North v the South. Lack of any early outdoor practice contributed to **Sevenoaks'** only defeat by Sutton Valence, and thereafter they performed creditably, beating Maidstone, Reigate and King's, Rochester. Captain K. R. Storey batted attractively, and his wicket-keeping record (13 stumpings and 9 catches) reveals the strength of the bowling: P. N. Colman's left-arm chinamen and googlies and R. P. L. Styles' orthodox left-arm slows. Styles hit the only century, and a 91, and there was a series of high scores by J. M. Tavaré. **Gresham**, with a strong all-round team, did well early in the season. Fast bowlers N. S. Taylor and D. R. McG. Bruce-Lockhart put in some good performances, as did N. B. Chesworth (medium) and the captain and all-rounder J. D. Cordeaux (slow left-arm).

Taunton, enjoying their best season since 1966, had wins over King's College Taunton, Kingswood and Bishop Vesey's and their only defeat was to MCC. C. M. Pleeth was particularly impressive, scoring 91 in the draw v Millfield and an unbeaten hundred v the Old Boys. **Canford's** defeat by Bryanston was their only one, but a strong batting side and an attack lacking variation and penetration was a recipe for draws, not wins. Against Blundell's, P. B. Taylor (169) and A. D. Walker (109 not out) put on 303 for the first wicket – a school record for any wicket. G. C. Gowar took five or more wickets v Downside, Bradfield and Sherborne. Best performance of the season for King's, Gloucester was T. J. Edward's 79 and three for 9 with leg-spin v the Old Boys. The medium-pace seamer, M. A. Ford, took eight for 13 v Gloucester Clergy. **Sedbergh** returned from their Centenary tour of Trinidad and Tobago to a wet, almost cricket-less May. N. A. P. Meadows bowled fast and straight for his 36 wickets while S. A. Hall, with aggressive fast-scoring, kept some of the Caribbean spirit alive.

Five of **Eton's** school matches were abandoned without a ball bowled, and having to field in the rain brought about their only defeat. R. J. Compton Burnett's 109 not out v Bradfield was a first-class innings; the bowling, however, lacked consistency and even the most successful bowler, C. J. Davis, failed to realise fully his potential. **Reed's**, with a young side, lacked the strength to turn draws into victories but were satisfied with an unbeaten record in inter-school matches. The captain, P. E. E. Farenden, headed the batting for the second year. **Rossall**, dependent for success on the fast bowling of S. R. Langford, the captain, were handicapped by the weather in early matches. A. C. Jones, with an average of 50, held the batting together.

Allhallows, with victories over seven other schools, had their best playing record for years. Opening bowlers S. C. Ellyatt and S. Crabtree took 90 wickets – the basis for the side's success as the batsmen were able to score the required runs for the loss of few wickets. S. Collins (119) scored the school's first century since 1969. **Dauntsey's** strength also lay in their fast bowling – the quartet of N. R. A. Gallow, T. L. Hardingham, S. M. Hassall and A. B. Leng – and only one school took more than 100 off them. It was left to the early-order batsmen, usually, to score the runs needed for victory. The school's two defeats were by adult sides. **Sherborne**, another with two losses but unbeaten by a school, finished their home season with wins over Marlborough and Cheltenham College. The batting was consistent and an enthusiastic side was outstanding in the field. A talented and exuberant **Stockport Grammar XI** enjoyed an excellent season full of positive results. With A. Oakes (medium-fast) and T. M. Taylor (slow left-arm) in good form throughout, other sides were unable to take advantage of a batting line-up that could be brittle once A. T. C. Caro and S. Mountain departed. Opposing batsmen did, however, benefit from a number of dropped catches.

Bedford Modern, with a young XI, recorded wins over Kimbolton, Wellingborough, St Edmund's Ware, and Wolverhampton GS and were 2 runs off victory over KES, Birmingham, against whom the captain, J. R. James, scored an unbeaten 101. A. K. G. Jones, an under 15, showed promise as an all-rounder. **Marlborough**, for whom the left-handed E. Cunningham passed 70 on seven occasions, were unbeaten until the last week of term, when Rugby upset them. Their spin attack of Cunningham (off-spin) and M. Swallow developed well and will be a force in 1980. **Merchant Taylors', Northwood** lost their final school match to end what would have been a third successive season unbeaten by a school – a run of 22 matches. The batting was consistent and the bowling steady rather than hostile; N. D. Mills proved to be an acrobatic wicket-keeper. With most of the side returning in 1980, prospects are promising. Another late-season loser was **Brighton College**, whose young side (six under 16) could not adapt quickly enough to the demands of limited-overs cricket and Northern wickets at the King's, Macclesfield Festival. Success was built around the steady medium-pace bowling of D. R. Thompson and J. A. St J. Withers.

Mill Hill, despite starting the season with only three recognised bowlers, beat Oundle, Stowe, Haileybury, Nottingham HS and UCS to conclude the most successful decade in the school's history. L. C. Newton (fast), I. Maciver (slow left-arm), D. S. Michie and S. C. Greenslade (both medium-pace) formed the best Mill Hill attack since 1945. **Repton** included good wins over Rugby and Cheltenham in their seven victories, but they lost a good game to Shrewsbury. J. M. G. Richardson was an outstanding captain and batsman, averaging 66.50. J. M. G. Willatt showed ability, and N. G. B. Richardson was the leading bowler.

Bedford had one of their best-ever seasons, with wins over The Leys, King William's, LoM, Stockport GS, St Edward's Oxford, Oundle, Uppingham and Repton. A feature of a superb fielding side was the slip catching of H. D. Ferguson, and all bowlers benefited. Two batting disasters, against Harrow and Marlborough, spoilt an otherwise excellent season for **Wellington**. Three batsmen scored hundreds by the end of the fifth match, and P. R. C. Edwards, who led the XI well, scored another in the end-of-term Festival. A. E. Robertson and J. A. Thom were effective opening bowlers in an attack that was accurate and hostile. **Tonbridge** had an enjoyable season; they beat Christ's Hospital, Westminster, Haileybury and Lancing and tied with Clifton. Three batsmen scored hundreds: C. C. Ellison (a right-arm seamer) and S. C. Miller (slow left-arm) both took 40 wickets. Three of the side – Cowdrey, Betts and Hickson – played in the Tonbridge Under 15 XI which won the Lord's Taverners' Cricketer Colts Trophy.

The following schools also lost only two games, although many fixtures were drawn. **Ampleforth**, who had five matches abandoned in May, lacked the bowling to dismiss other sides, and the batting lacked the experience and temperament to achieve wins against the clock. T. J. Beardmore-Gray, a sound opening batsman, was a schoolboy captain in the highest class. **Bradford GS** failed to play to their potential, with the leading batsmen lacking in consistency. S. G. P. Hewitt developed as a confident, lively 'keeper and forceful bat; opening bowler W. M. Adams enjoyed a successful season, taking 34 wickets. **Christ's Hospital** began impressively but lost momentum after half-term. A feature of their season was the batting of the captain, N. Konig, who hit two hundreds and five fifties in twelve innings.

Douai School, with only one loss to a school, had a good season, the outstanding player being the sixteen-year-old all-rounder R. Keeble. One of their four wins was over the MCC.

King's, Canterbury were badly hit by the weather in the first half of the season, but were favoured during a successful cricket week. G. D. P. Breeze led the side with a mature understanding of the game and was leading wicket-taker; M. J. D. Hancock was an accurate, successful opener. The batting revolved around the hard-hitting and fast running of R. A. Darko.

Monmouth School had the batting to amass winning totals but lacked bowlers to disturb batsmen playing for a draw. A. G. Davies began his season with 99 (run out) v Millfield and later scored a century v Worcester RGS. The captain, L. Benson, and M. G. Davies gave the side good starts, and L. M. R. Coombs scored quickly to set up the declaration. St Albans suffered their first defeat by a school in two years, collapsing from 80 for one to 129 all out against Haberdashers'. P. M. Richardson was the only really dominant batsman while C. A. Blythe, as expected, was leading wicket-taker, including a return of five for 8 in his 37 wickets. **Wrekin** lost only one match to a school and beat four others. J. B. R. Jones was again the outstanding player and took his all-round aggregate in four years to 2,011 runs and 159 wickets.

Epsom's season was fairly uneventful. The match against Christ's Hospital was drawn with the scores level, and Cranleigh won off the last ball of the match. The captain, J. M. Gould, hit the season's highest score (78); M. A. Fahmy was the leading bowler. King Edward VI, Stourbridge, in a season of rebuilding, had an inexperienced batting line-up and bowling which lacked penetration. To their credit, the school was rarely bowled out. The only defeat by a school was in the last over, when any of four results was possible. King's School, Ely had a disappointing year. Though the early batting was reliable, the later order lacked application and the side failed to press home advantages on several occasions. The bowling, mostly medium-pace, was always sound.

Reading, with a young side, are in a position to look ahead rather than back for ten of the final XI will be available in 1980. P. D. C. Gibson inspired his team with some fine bowling and there were some good team performances. N. P. Brownlow was the leading batsman. **Reigate GS** had a similar transitional year with a number of young players being given opportunities. Outstanding was the ESCA representative N. J. Falkner, whose 578 runs included six fifties. He also took 23 wickets with his off-spinners. A. M. Babington, at fifteen, looked extremely hostile, and with the even younger M. Boden to support him the attack should not lack the ability to worry opposing batsmen. Another young team, **St Peter's, York**, had a successful season, winning five school matches and losing only one. Wicket-keeper-batsman C. W. Burdass led the XI capably, and results were based on all-round depth rather than individual performance. The main bowling was distinctive for the fact that all four were left-armers.

Truro, in a season which saw the revival of their tour of Devon and Somerset, was captained by all-rounder P. Triniman, whose excellent bowling (54 wickets, average 7.25) was the outstanding feature. Three times he took seven wickets in an innings. **Worksop's** season was plagued by injuries and the full XI never once played together in a school match. The bowling was adequate but the batting was too inexperienced to build winning totals.

The following schools lost three or more matches but still won more than they lost. **Emanuel**, with a number of newly promoted players, had notable wins over Alleyn's, RGS Guildford and Kingston GS and lost by fewer than 10 runs to MCC, Surrey Young Cricketers and Old Emanuel. For **Hampton School**, J. C. R. Hall, a right-arm leg-spinner, captured a record 63 wickets; T. S. Bishop represented NAYC against MCC Schools at Lord's. The XI won more than half their fixtures. **Solihull's** main strength was their bowling (four took more than 30 wickets) and keen fielding. The batting was always productive. There were good wins over Brighton College, King's Macclesfield, and KES Birmingham, and only three school matches were lost. **King's, Macclesfield** also suffered only three defeats by schools. Two players stood out in a side, all of whom made valuable contributions: G. P. Jenion scored two hundreds in his 798 runs, took 35 wickets, and held 22 catches in the outfield; N. D. Smedley, in his first year in the side, scored 602 runs.

Shrewsbury, with a young side ably led by A. J. Pollock, beat Rossall, Repton, Denstone and Rugby, but lost to Uppingham, Malvern and Charterhouse. T. C. Skelton hit two hundreds in school matches, while R. G. W. Marsh captured 69 wickets – a post-war record for the school – five times taking seven or more wickets with his leg-spinners. Both played in the representative matches at Eastbourne. **Eastbourne College** overcame a disappointing start to finish on a high note with wins over Clifton and Winchester. No side made more than

150 against them, and Lancing were bowled out for 44. P. R. Mansell and V. Patel were the main strike bowlers. The batting was led by P. A. N. Armstrong, who displayed class and concentration in his hundreds v Brighton and Lancing. J. P. Payne and J. P. Webber also scored heavily.

Nottingham HS featured in a number of high-scoring games, as evidenced by runs scored by their batsmen and against their bowlers, though M. J. Bancroft, S. J. Turrill and P. A. J. Gregory all took more than 40 wickets. **Perse School, Cambridge** fielded probably their best all-round side since the mid-1950s, winning eight and losing two school matches. K. F. Haydon batted and bowled to effect, J. M. D. McKinley's right-arm medium-pace was extremely accurate, and R. T. Fowlds scored the only hundred. **William Hulme's GS** also won eight, including those against Rydal, Arnold and Merchant Taylors', Crosby. Fast bowler P. A. Rainford took 70 wickets and won selection for HMC Schools; wicket-keeper P. G. Turner held a record 27 catches.

With a young team, **Woodhouse Grove** enjoyed a successful season with seven wins over schools and two defeats. The team's strength lay in the accurate medium-pace bowling of A. M. Widdop and the Robinson brothers, plus good fielding. The batting was heavily dependent on N. J. Driver, the captain, and D. A. Robinson. For **Monkton Combe**, A. K. S. Gough had a splendid all-round season while M. J. C. Edwards, in his second year as captain, contributed to the success of the summer both with the bat and behind the stumps. **Cheltenham GS** relied heavily on the experience and run-making of M. Breddy, whose leadership of a very young side ensured a successful season. The bowling was insufficiently incisive to allow the batsmen an easy passage and several scores over 180 were needed to obtain wins.

By general consent, **Merchiston Castle** were the leading school in Scotland, undefeated in schools fixtures with wins over George Watson's, George Heriot's, Glenalmond, Loretto and Edinburgh Academy. Wicket-keeper R. A. Young was a positive captain of an XI with depth in batting. Each of the first eight batsmen made at least one fifty. **Edinburgh Academy** went into the last week of term unbeaten by a school – and then lost twice. Over-reliance on the batting of J. D. Sutton and several sub-standard fielding performances were weaknesses, but there was promise in the all-round form of the fifteen-year-old C. D. Fraser-Darling. **Gordonstoun** had an average season and report a difficulty in obtaining good school fixtures. The batting proved adequate but the bowling lacked penetration.

After a pleasing start to the season, **Sutton Valence** tailed off badly as exams and injuries took their toll. The captain, J. E. Skinner, led the batting and bowling and would have done even better with more support. His six for 34 almost brought off a famous victory over unbeaten Trinity, Croydon. **Ashville College**, despite an abundance of runs, lacked the bowling to force victories and, in relation to 1978, the season was a moderate one. S. J. Simpson, the captain and wicket-keeper, scored 847 runs, a new school record. **Leeds GS** ended their season with a flourish, obtaining five of their seven wins against schools on consecutive days at the end of term. R. H. Sharp, the captain, enjoyed a good season with the bat and bowling his off-spinners. The medium-pace opener M. W. Hopkins took most wickets; P. Stoker scored most runs.

Abingdon, winning five of their twelve school matches, owed much to a good bowling and fielding side, though A. R. Thomas and A. R. A. Johnson topped 500 runs. **Bancroft's** strength was their depth in batting. The bowling, despite good returns by S. Allen (medium) and M. F. Wilkinson (slow left-arm), had difficulty bowling out other sides. Three matches were won on a six-match tour of Denmark. **Elizabeth College, Guernsey** lost only one school match, to Millfield, and the highpoint of their six wins was a "double" over the "old enemy", Victoria College, Jersey. Left-arm medium-pacer J. W. Lihou gave sterling service, often bowling twenty overs unchanged; P. D. Wakeford led the side well and received wonderful support from wicket-keeper-batsman S. R. Sullivan.

Merchant Taylors', Crosby had strong batting but only two bowlers, S. S. C. Burnett (medium) and T. J. Bostock (off-spin) troubled opposing batsmen. N. P. Gleeson hit the school's first century for six years; Bostock captained the side with a refreshingly independent spirit. **Framlingham's** record improved after some early losses. S. A. R. Ferguson reached a record aggregate of 705 runs for the season, including two centuries, and the captain, M. J. Shults, reached three figures. **Bishop's Stortford** also began with defeats – by Felsted and the Perse, but went on to beat Aldenham, Framlingham, Kimbolton, Hymers College Hull, and

MCC (by four wickets with the target of 232 met in the last over). They had a promising all-rounder in M. I. Thompson, still an under 16, who scored 427 runs and took 41 wickets with his right-arm leg-spinners.

Denstone, with a mainly seam attack, prospered as the weather brightened; D. W. Heath and all-rounder N. J. B. Illingworth looked decidedly quick at times and were well backed up by A. J. de Belder, the captain, and M. J. Rhodes. A spinner might have helped turn some drawn matches into victories. The school has obtained the services of the former Test player, H. J. Rhodes, as full-time professional. **King Henry VIII, Coventry** suffered all four defeats late in the season, one of them in the final of the Warwickshire Under 19 knockout semi-final. A. Savage stood out in a powerful batting line-up; the bowling suffered from a lack of pace. **Trent College**, in school matches, won five and lost two. Outstanding performances were seven for 41 by J. Groszek (medium) v Cranbrook and R. M. Sanders' century.

Hurstpierpoint's strongest feature was the seam bowling of C. J. Cowley and D. L. Carnegie, backed by excellent fielding. Too often poor middle-order batting let them down. Batting was the strong point of **Ipswich's XI**: the captain, M. D. Bailey, scored 202 not out against Duke of York's School, and another hundred the next day. M. Bryden and J. Chessher also hit hundreds. The only loss to a school was to the strong Felsted XI. Lack of consistency by the middle order is reflected in the results of **Magdalen College School, Oxford**. The good starts of P. S. Morris and C. J. Lloyd were often squandered, and the bowling, though accurate, was short of bite.

St Dunstan's young side were unbeaten at school level, and with ten of the side returning look with confidence to 1980. Missing will be the 1979 captain and outstanding batsman, C. T. Carpenter. **Bryanston**, captained by J. D. Baker with personal success, recorded wins over King's Bruton, Hardye's, Bishop Wordsworth and Canford after a rain-spoilt early term. The left-handed all-rounder D. J. Ticehurst (16) looked promising. **Clifton**, with an outstanding batting line-up, played positive, attractive cricket, aiming for and achieving an average of twenty per hour. There were wins over Cheltenham, Winchester and Felsted, plus a tie with Tonbridge, having been set 220 in 45 overs. Highlights were C. R. Trembath's unbeaten 200 (out of 315 for six) v Cheltenham and 129 v Marlborough; M. Bailey's hundred v Millfield and M. C. Arrindell's 106 not out in 114 minutes v Felsted – a true captain's innings. **Charterhouse** again had a happy and eventually successful side under R. C. Doggart. In the Festival, 740 runs were scored for the loss of seventeen wickets and Shrewsbury and Malvern were beaten. Batting highlights were M. C. Frankland's 100 v Rugby and innings of 40, 85, and 50 by fifteen-year-old W. R. Bristowe.

Bowling was the strength of **King's College, Taunton**. S. C. Hunter ripped through the Blundell's batting to set up a win with seven for 27, and J. D. J. Stewart (fast-medium) took five wickets on four occasions. Scoring sufficient runs was often a problem for a young side. **Oakham**, another young side, learnt much from their season. They had an excellent all-rounder in D. M. Kingham, who took five or more wickets in an innings four times. **Winchester's** season was dominated by their two representative players, S. J. G. Doggart, the captain, and A. R. Crocker, the vice-captain. The left-handed Doggart featured an unbeaten 102 v Marlborough and 111 not out and 64 v Eton in his 743 runs; Crocker, right-arm fast, had best figures of seven for 33 v Free Foresters.

Wycliffe had a keen fielding side and consistent bowling, but the top-order batting rarely provided the necessary basis for an innings. S. H. R. Judd was a talented fast-medium seam bowler and was well supported by A. C. Jones. **Blundell's** season was dominated by the batting of H. Morris, who scored 628 runs (average 89.71) despite missing three matches with a cracked shin-bone. The captain, S. McG. B. Robertson, set a splendid example in the field but was handicapped by an erratic, unproductive attack. **Forest's** inexperienced XI found runs hard to get in the wet first half of term, but prospects improved with the promotion of two exciting colts – M. Hussain, stylish batsman and off-break bowler, and I. Crossley, leg-spinner and neat batsman.

Malvern's season was happier than results indicate, for two of the three defeats followed generous Malvern declarations and many of the draws were close. M. E. Fordham's 648 runs were the highest aggregate for some years, while P. J. Prifti, captain and wicket-keeper, welded together a keenly competitive side. **Radley** drew most of their major school matches, and with the XI's outstanding player, J. A. N. Wootten (off-spinner), one of eight available in 1980 prospects are bright.
