



SCHOOLS CRICKET IN 1980

In a summer when cricket was badly disrupted by poor weather, the English Schools Cricket Association considered themselves fortunate to get through their programme of Regional matches without interference. The games at Eastbourne, however, did suffer from the rain. The allocated wicket at The Saffrons was not considered suitable for a two-day game but, with the co-operation of the ground authorities and the umpires, two one-day games were played on different pitches.

More discouraging than the inclement weather, though, was the evidence from coaching courses and the Regional matches that the standard of schools players was not as high as in recent years. Although N. J. Falkner, T. J. Kent and G. J. Little all played good innings, the seamers sound and economical. The two principal spinners, A. W. J. Spiller and E. J. Cunningham, also gave little away but the slow pitches restricted their striking-rate. The fielding, with wicket-keeper P. Gill and Spiller being notable exceptions, rarely lived up to the standard expected from schools teams and at times was little above ordinary. P. A. Davis, despite failing to bat to his full potential, led the side well in a difficult year, being particularly successful with his bowling changes.

In the representative matches, the English Schools beat the Welsh Schools by ten wickets and drew with the Scottish CU Colts and Irish Schools. The latter match, at the County Ground, Bristol, was the first ever fixture between the English and Irish Schools and featured a century by Little in England's slowly built innings of 162 for seven declared. The Irish, playing six of their national Youth team which contested the final of the 1979 International Youth Tournament, declared at 136 for six, but rain on the second day foiled their enterprise. The highlight of the victory over the Welsh Schools was the bowling of C. Penn. On as first change, he took seven for 12 in twelve overs as the Welsh were bundled out for 65 in their first innings, in which Gill took five catches.

Reports from the Schools

Abingdon's strength lay in their bowling as promising off-spinner R. I. McCreery (40 wickets), as well as seam bowlers W. K. Mellor and S. J. Minter, successfully exploited the damp wickets. MCC were among four clubs defeated. Tight fielding and resilient batting offset some wayward bowling to give Alleyn's School their most successful season for some years, their only defeat being by Emanuel. Opening batsmen S. Banfield and left-hander J. Lyne were well supported by the captain, W. Manhood, who hit four fifties. Fast-medium bowler R. Cowland returned eight for 14 v Royal Russell. With ten of the First XI available in 1981, prospects are good. Allhallows, in a transitional year, built their side around M. J. Davies, an all-rounder who was ably supported by wicket-keeper-batsman S. R. Dryden and fast-medium bowler M. W. R. Luff. Ampleforth's fine all-round performance featured splendid batting, with J. P. Barrett – also a fine slip – scoring two centuries and A. C. Calder-Smith batting powerfully at

number six. D. H. Harrison excelled behind the stumps while opening bowler S. D. Lawson and off-spinner M. C. T. Low bowled efficiently.

Bablake remain undefeated by a school since 1978, their only defeat being by an Old Boys XI. Opener C. L. Flick scored two centuries and fourteen-year-old D. A. Thorne achieved a magnificent unbeaten 134. Opening bat and fast-medium bowler W. P. Matthews scored most runs and took most wickets. The school retained the Warwickshire and Birmingham Senior Schools knockout trophy. A tour of Denmark followed a successful domestic season for **Bancroft's School**. Highlights included C. R. Thomas's record aggregate of 647 runs, and the promising all-round showing of opening bowler S. W. Grant and off-spinner I. P. Debnam. **Barnard Castle**, with good wins over St Bees, Whitehaven GS, Stockport GS, and William Hulme's GS, and only one loss – v Ashville – were indebted to valuable contributions with bat and ball from left-handed batsmen R. Andrew (right-arm medium) and A. Frater (right-arm medium-fast). **Bedford School's** batting was dominated by H. D. Ferguson, who hit an unbeaten 125 v Stowe. Not only schoolboys were troubled by the inswing of S. P. Clayton, who was well supported by N. J. Cowell, I. T. Osborne and some tidy, aggressive fielding. Schools beaten were The Leys, Oundle, Bedford Modern, Uppingham and Repton.

Defeated by only two schools – Denstone and Bedford – **Bedford Modern** recorded wins over St Albans, Kimbolton, The Perse, Oakham, Bishop Vesey's, and RGS Worcester. A. Fordham captained the victorious U. 15 XI at Lord's; his opening partner, A. K. G. Jones, topped 800 runs. **Berkhamsted** struggled until captain M. J. Parsons (right-arm medium) took over the new-ball attack. He also hit 78 in 42 minutes in their only school win, v Magdalen College School, although the batting was mainly in the hands of P. J. Allen and B. G. Evans. **Bethany School's** only defeat was by Wellingborough. Batting averages were headed by fast-medium bowler J. Hancock, who hit 50 in 21 minutes v St Edmund's, Canterbury, and played for Kent Schools U. 19. Left-hander N. Kimber strengthened the middle order and J. Blunden provided solid all-round support.

A young **Birkenhead** side remained unbeaten by a school, despite missed chances and an attack which lacked penetration, apart from the promising off-spin of R. C. A. Thorn. S. T. Crawley hit 170 in two hours v Stonyhurst (ten 6s and fifteen 4s) and 101 in 80 minutes v Liverpool College. **Bishop's Stortford College** beat The Perse, Chigwell, Aldenham, and Kimbolton but, weakened by examinations, lost to Sherborne, Queen's Taunton, and Taunton school during a West Country tour. Their strength lay in depth of batting, although the bowling was tighter than previously, with off-spinner R. E. Jackson topping the averages. **Bloxham's** inexperienced side, with an attack generally lacking penetration, were indebted to the leg-spin of P. A. D. Farrar for their two wins. A young **Blundell's** side relied for runs on their captain, left-hander H. Morris, who made five fifties. He was well supported by off-spinner P. D. Langdon, who three times took five or more wickets in an innings. S. A. Watts (right-arm fast-medium) took six for 21 v Sidmouth. M. T. G. Lairibeer scored a century in 83 minutes for **Bradfield College**, whose wins included Westminster, Canford, and Wellington.

Bradford GS, with a young side, recorded eight wins. Their fielding was accurate, with G. M. Fitzpatrick a fine slip, and wicket-keeper S. G. P. Hewitt claiming 39 victims as well as batting productively. The attack was spear-headed by left-arm paceman J. D. Thompson, while C. J. Hewitt, in his first season, claimed 30 wickets with his off-spinners. **Brentwood's** season was dominated by their captain, I. L. Pont, who took 35 per cent of the wickets and scored 33 per cent of the runs, his total of 858 setting a new record. He represented MCC Schools at Lord's. Bowlers N. Hanworth and J. Hollington both showed promise. With a strong all-round side, **Brighton** were unbeaten by a school, their most notable victory being over Epsom when captain C. J. Edmonds scored 96 not out in an hour. Medium-pace bowlers D. R. Thomson and J. A. St J. Withers led a tight attack. A young **Bryanston** side beat Taunton, Dauntsey's, and Monkton Combe, losing to only one school – **Canford**, whose other wins included King's Taunton and MCC. Canford's bowling was poor, although J. W. R. Edwards took six for 21 v MCC, and they owed much to their captain, P. B. Taylor, as well as outstanding fielder N. M. C. Fleming.

Highlights for **Charterhouse** included seven fifties by left-handed batsman C. E. G. Allen, 124 before lunch v Westminster by captain G. P. Bristowe, and seven for 37 v Bradfield by slow right-arm off-spinner J. B. D. North. **Cheltenham College** had a disappointing season, with R. H. B. Johnson and R. M. Tucker holding most innings together at five and six. The

return after injury of off-spinner A. D. Marsh strengthened the side after half-term. Accurate bowling highlighted a successful season for **Cheltenham Grammar School**, whose splendid batting performance was led by A. White. Rebuilding their side, **Christ College, Brecon**, were encouraged by the powerful batting of N. C. Hanson, and a return of eight for 31 v St David's University from P. G. Chambers (slow left-arm).

Christ's Hospital, whose only win was v Cranleigh, depended mainly on captain N. Konig and all-rounder P. Cunliffe. **Clifton** beat Tonbridge, Eastbourne, Downside, Blundell's, and Colston's losing to Taunton and Winchester. They were indebted to productive batting from M. W. Bailey as well as excellent returns by their opening bowlers, each of whom did the hat-trick; N. R. Gillespie v Downside and C. R. Trembath v Winchester. A successful tour of Holland for **Colfe's School** followed a rewarding season, which included wins v Emanuel, Chigwell, Haberdashers' Aske's (Hatcham) and Trinity Croydon (by seven wickets). Strong batting featured outstanding performances by A. Caswall and captain N. Tarrant, while the bowling was led by A. Rodgers and R. Mirza, who took his 150th wicket for the First XI. Fourteen-year-old W. M. Smith led **Colston's School's** batting, with 639 runs, as they recorded wins v Monmouth, King Edward's Bath, Cotham GS, and Bristol Cathedral School. In a mediocre season, **Cranbrook's** only noteworthy performance was a first-ever win v Incogniti CC.

Dauntsey's strong and varied attack was led by R. S. Spencer (right-arm medium), who returned eight for 14 v Kingswood, seven for 62 v Dean Close and three for 5 v Marlborough. They overcame inexperienced batting to beat Wycliffe, Marlborough, KES Bath, and Kingswood, with only one school defeat – by Bryanston. The school has introduced cricket for girls in the younger age group. A win v Malvern was the highlight for **Dean Close** in a season when poor catching prevented more wins. M. P. A. Crawshaw was top-scorer, while leg-spinner T. Jackson recorded nine for 50 v Bloxham. A young but successful **Denstone** side featured prolific batting, excellent fielding and a tight attack, with A. D. Coley (right-arm medium) taking seven for 40 v Ellesmere. In addition, left-arm spinner J. P. D. Cadman took eight for 64 v Bedford Modern and his five for 11 v King's, Tynemouth, included the hat-trick. **Dover College's** most notable victory was v Sutton Valence, when I. A. C. Syer hit 50 in under half an hour. In another game he hit four consecutive 6s. Apart from the performance of captain J. G. Ryeland, the bowling was weak and the fielding inconsistent.

In a transitional year, **Downside** were indebted to captain T. A. Cotterell (slow left-arm), who took seven for 66 v Free Foresters, and wicket-keeper-batsman M. J. Poland whose 561 runs were twice as many as the next highest aggregate. An experienced **Dulwich College** batting side often disappointed, and only W. K. Jarrett (right-arm medium) gave penetration to an attack without an experienced spinner. A young **Durham** team beat Scarborough, St Bees, RGS Newcastle, and Durham Pilgrims. P. C. Shaw and J. R. Thompson scored well; the attack, led by captain M. R. Fletcher (right-arm fast), was nicely balanced by spinners N. P. Tubbs and J. C. McKenna.

In a season of rebuilding **Eastbourne College** achieved good wins v Christ's Hospital and King's Canterbury, when N. B. Chapple (right-arm fast-medium) took seven for 25. R. D. Montgomery was a successful all-rounder and captain P. A. N. Armstrong played for MCC Schools at Lord's. **Edinburgh Academy** were unbeaten in Scotland, their only loss being to Pocklington. Outstanding batsman J. D. Sutton scored three centuries and sixteen-year-old C. D. Fraser-Darling (two centuries) fell just four wickets short of the double of 500 runs and 50 wickets. **Elizabeth College, Guernsey**, recorded four school victories: v Victoria College (twice) with all-rounder D. J. Mecham (right-arm medium) taking five for 15 and captain C. J. Gilbert (right-arm slow-medium) taking four for 12, v Hampton with all-rounder J. R. Ravenscroft (right-arm medium) taking seven for 52, and v King Edward's, Witley, when A. G. Tapp (slow left-arm) took four for 17.

Ellesmere's strength lay in the batting of captain R. E. J. Watt, who passed 90 three times in five innings, and fourteen-year-old G. L. Home. However, lack of bowling prevented greater success. A young **Eltham College** side, ably led by all-rounder N. I. Holcombe, were restricted by a weak middle order who often failed to complement the advantage won by a tight attack. R. A. Mellors returned nine for 32 and M. J. Wright eight for 38, both v Haberdashers' Aske's, while M. R. Surguy and fifteen-year-old M. J. Holcombe made useful contributions with bat and ball. **Emanuel** were indebted to a powerful batting side for their twenty wins, which included those v Tiffin, Kingston GS, KCS Wimbledon, and Reigate GS. They also won the

London Schools knockout trophy for the third year. J. C. Waite scored 1,056 runs, with two hundreds and seven fifties, as well as taking 34 wickets.

A highlight for **Epsom College** was a stand of 184 v Old Epsomians by J. M. Paulus and N. L. Porter. The bowling was led by newcomers M. J. Morris (right-arm medium) and off-spinner R. M. C. Williams. **Eton** were undefeated and recorded wins v Charterhouse and St Paul's. The batting was led by C. C. Birch Reynardson and D. C. E. Russell and the bowling by M. J. B. Rudd (right-arm fast-medium). **Exeter School** were indebted for their strong attack to P. Sykes (medium-fast) and P. Bates (slow left-arm), both of whom were selected for the Devon U. 19 team. However, the batting often failed to fulfil its potential.

Felsted, undefeated by a British school for the fifth time in six years, beat Ipswich, Bedford, Eastbourne, and Tonbridge. Attacking batsman R. N. R. Vartan scored six fifties in his last seven matches, and was well supported by promising wicket-keeper M. W. C. Olley. I. P. Mason (medium) took three wickets or more on eight occasions and B. H. Pinkerton (slow left-arm) gave little away. With brilliant fielding and strong batting, **Fettes** were unbeaten, recording wins v St Bees, Glenalmond, Strathallan, Merchiston, and The Leys. Their bowling was erratic, although R. J. Orr (fast-medium) returned five for 22 v St Bees, six for 18 v Glenalmond, four for 11 v Strathallan and eight for 37 v Headmaster's XI, while C. I. McCrostie's off-spin claimed five for 15 v Merchiston and six for 23 v The Leys. A young **Forest School** side – eight were under sixteen – enjoyed a successful season with all-rounder J. Crossley (right-arm fast-medium) heading both batting and bowling averages. He hit his maiden century v City of London, when he shared in a partnership of 136 with his brother I. Crossley, and took nine for 58 v MCC.

Giggleswick, ably led by all-rounder G. J. Hartley (right-arm medium-fast), enjoyed a better season than they expected.

Unbeaten by a school for the fourth year, **Haberdashers' Aske's**, Elstree, lost only to MCC. Prolific batting by R. G. Price, M. C. Wilcock, N. Colverd and captain C. R. Churchman provided sufficient runs for an attack which improved towards the end of the season. All-rounder N. M. M. Andrews effectively led **Hampton** to victory over thirteen schools, including St Paul's, Emanuel, Tiffin, and Enfield. Highlights included an opening stand of 230 v St Benedict's by K. M. Wood and C. B. Dennis-Baker, and four wickets in four balls by T. Lambert v Tiffin. Again undefeated by a school, **Harrow** beat Wellington, Winchester, and St Edward's. Above-average bowling featured O. F. O. Findlay (right-arm fast-medium) and, in a solid batting side, S. E. Haggas scored a century v Wellington in his first match. With no wins, a young **Highgate XI** failed to fulfil their promise.

Hipperholme GS had a frustrating season, often narrowly avoiding victory, although they beat King's Macclesfield and Giggleswick. Apart from opening pair C. A. Heppenstall and R. S. Butterworth, the batting was inconsistent. Slow bowlers A. Furness (off-spin) and M. J. Hopwood (left-arm) took most wickets. **Hurstpierpoint** were encouraged by the performances of their captain, the hard-hitting left-hander, H. K. Bellamy, promising opening bat M. N. J. Rose, and right-arm off-spinner S. M. A. West, who took eight for 18 v Seaford College.

Wins over The Perse and MCC encouraged **Kimbolton**, although they often fell short of expectations. J. S. Chambers headed the batting, while S. C. Render showed promise as an all-rounder. **King Edward's School, Birmingham**, were hampered for half the season by the absence through injury of all-rounder S. E. Fletcher. While C. D. Jenkins (medium) capably led the attack and the fielding was sound, the batting was often slow. A win v MCC brought some satisfaction. A young **King Edward VI College, Stourbridge**, side included a number of attacking batsmen, notably D. Scriven, who hit 96 in 78 minutes with two 6s and seventeen 4s. Leg-spinner D. Glover and left-arm seamer P. N. Shillington bowled effectively on wickets often affected by the wet summer. With a weak batting side, **King Edward VI School, Southampton**, were indebted for their nine wins to a hostile attack, led by captain G. P. J. Staples and D. M. M. Horne.

King Edward VII School, Lytham, had decisive wins v Burnley GS and St Mary's, Crosby. In a young team G. F. H. McDonnell was outstanding, both in the field and with the bat. The batting of **King Henry VIII School, Coventry**, was ably led by wicket-keeper-captain A. Savage, but, apart from promising newcomer C. J. J. Harrison (right-arm medium), their bowling lacked pace. **King's College, Taunton**, beat King's School Bruton, Plymouth College,

Monmouth, Blundell's, Downside, and MCC. The attack featured three seam bowlers: S. C. Hunter (right-arm fast), who took seven wickets v Queen's Taunton and v King's Bruton, N. K. Gane (right-arm fast-medium) and fourteen-year-old all-rounder R. J. Harden (left-arm medium) who took seven wickets v Monmouth. Batting was adequate but unspectacular and the fielding tidy. **King's College School, Wimbledon**, were indebted for a successful season to strong all-round performances from captain K. R. Thompson, wicket-keeper M. A. Staniland, R. I. Ali Khan and A. M. Bredin, whose slow left-arm spin was especially pleasing.

Slow and inconsistent scoring hampered **King's School, Bruton**. Their fielding was alert, with P. F. McIntyre excelling in the slips, and the captain, S. E. Birks, impressed with his slow bowling in an attack which gave little away. In a successful season, **King's School, Canterbury**, beat Highgate, Dulwich, and KCS Wimbledon, their only defeat being by Eastbourne College. C. P. Smith scored 189 not out v Dulwich, with six 6s and 27 4s, reaching 100 in 76 minutes and 150 in 105 minutes. M. F. Nicholson took eight for 20 v St Lawrence College, Ramsgate. **The King's School, Chester**, lost only to Aldenham, and might have won more matches had their bowling been more penetrative. With a record eleven school wins, **King's School, Macclesfield**, defeated William Hulme's GS, Stockport GS, Solihull, and Nottingham HS. They were ably led by all-rounder N. A. Kennington (off-breaks) whose fielding was exceptional. Wicket-keeper P. Moores had more stumpings than catches, reflecting a refreshing use of three spin bowlers, and opener N. D. Smedley led the batting with 801 runs at 44.50.

A young **King William's College** side owed much to the all-round skills of captain P. N. Luft, a strong, attacking batsman and right-arm medium-fast bowler. In an improved season, **Kingston GS** defeated St Paul's, St George's Weybridge, and MCC. R. J. Purchase headed the batting, with useful support from P. W. Ramussen and left-hander C. J. Cookman. Leading bowlers were I. C. P. Cranston (medium-fast) and leg-spinner R. D. S. Blackford, who took seven for 45 v St Benedict's, Ealing. **Kingswood's** strong batting side was built around W. P. Mason, G. D. open and wicket-keeper S. A. Gynes. Opening bowler T. J. Rawson (right-arm medium) took six for 31 (all bowled) v King Edward's, Bath.

Lancing College recorded only one school win – v Ardingly, when M. P. Rudge did the hat-trick. The off-spin of fourteen-year-old C. S. Mays was promising, while captain M. C. Calvert-Lee and brothers P. R. and S. R. Nash batted consistently. On a tour of Holland the side was undefeated, with right-arm seamer N. S. Tudball leading the bowling. For **Leeds GS** the highlight of a disappointing season, with only three wins, was a tie v QEGS, Wakefield, whose last eight wickets fell for 17. Leading wicket-takers were captain M. D. Sims (slow left-arm) and S. A. Gray (slow right-arm). Unbeaten **Leighton Park School** fielded a strong batting side, with opening bat G. J. Nienow averaging 50.75. C. D. S. Houston bowled with pace and penetration and V. Aluvihare took six for 22 v Bearwood, who were bowled out for 53. Other wins were v Reading Bluecoat and Shiplake. Keen fielding by **Liverpool College** was not adequately supported. Apart from the opening attack of M. B. Jenkins and T. F. Groom, the bowling lacked variety, and the batting was weak. There were wins v Rydal School and King William's College.

The strength of the **Lord Wandsworth College XI** lay in its batting, led by openers T. J. Coulson (captain) and sixteen-year-old S. Bentley. Apart from T. R. Jermyn (off-spin) the bowlers rarely dominated and best performances came when the school batted second. Again unbeaten by a school, **Lord Williams's School** beat RGS High Wycombe, Magdalen College School, St George's Harpenden, and MCC. A strong opening attack featured right-arm fast bowlers G. Porter and S. D. Thomson, who took seven for 29 v MCC. Only captain N. Yeomans batted with any confidence on the slow wickets. A young **Loretto** side had a disappointing season, depending heavily on R. S. Macaskill to score runs. Captain A. A. M. Macbeath bowled economically, taking six for 15 v George Watson's in the school's only win and three for 3 v Heriots. He was well supported by C. R. Marks.

Magdalen College School flourished under the captaincy of batsman P. S. Morris, with wins v Pangbourne, The Perse, Bloxham, St Bartholomew's, Bearwood, and Oratory. Their strength lay in the fast bowling of S. P. Hazell and S. C. Shorter, with six sides being bowled out for around 50. **Malvern's** successful season featured a record opening stand of 245 v Repton between M. E. Fordham and left-hander R. C. W. Mason. With 799 runs at 79.9, Fordham achieved both record aggregate and average. The team went on tour to Barbados at the end of term. In a season of exciting finishes, **Manchester GS** defeated Leeds GS, Bradford GS,

Highgate, and Dulwich College. The attack was well balanced, with fast bowlers D. Postlethwaite and M. J. Frost (six for 26 v Bolton GS) supported by left-arm M. P. Lawrence and off-spinner R. J. Clark. A. Milnes took five for 16 v QEGS, Blackburn, and totalled 325 runs.

In their best season for many years, **Marlborough** defeated Rugby, Radley, Cheltenham and Haileybury. Captain E. J. Cunningham, absent through injury until half-term, gave a fine all-round performance and represented MCC Schools. The standard of fielding was high. J. Mylne excelling behind the stumps while R. Hampel and M. R. C. Swallow were impressive outfielders. **Merchant Taylors'**, **Crosby**, had a disappointing season, with injuries to key players. C. N. Hughes D'Aeth bowled with maturity, taking seven for 33 v MCC. **Merchant Taylors'**, **Northwood**, took their strength from a productive batting side, with openers S. P. Ducat and J. P. Hoskins proving most effective. The attack was affected by injuries, although M. D. J. Ingram troubled opponents. A three-week tour of Canada was embarked on in August.

Merchiston Castle School's outstanding batsman was captain-wicket-keeper R. A. Young, in his fifth year in the XI. The bowling was led by D. Robinson (left-arm slow) and M. G. Robertson (right-arm fast-medium). **Mill Hill's** captain, C. I. Quirk, was handicapped by injury, but held some splendid catches and led his team to victory v Oundle, St Paul's, and Nottingham HS. Sixteen-year-old P. H. Wickenden scored heavily; T. A. J. Dawson bowled his off-breaks with increasing confidence. **Millfield** had one of their best-ever seasons, with three prolific batsmen P. G. Roebuck (left-hand), A. J. H. Dunning and S. J. Illingworth invariably giving them a good start. Fifteen-year-old off-spinner P. A. C. Bail was an outstanding prospect; captain J. O. Curran (right-arm fast) and A. R. Welch (right-arm medium-fast) were the leading wicket-takers.

Milton Abbey's one defeat by a school – Portsmouth GS – was in the last match of a successful season, for which they were indebted to J. M. D. Boswell whose accurate fast-medium bowling took a record 66 wickets and brought him a return of eight for 17 v King's School, Bruton. The batting was inconsistent, although G. H. Acheson-Gray was a powerful striker and R. D. T. Clive played some promising innings. A young **Monkton Combe** side gained valuable experience, with fifteen-year-old A. R. C Batterham (left-arm fast) claiming 38 wickets. **Monmouth's** young side was built around their captain A. G. Davies, who has appeared for Glamorgan Second XI and whose unbeaten 144 v Kingswood established a school record. The attack lacked penetration, but with ten of the team returning in 1981, prospects are good.

Norwich School's only victory was v King's Lynn School, when A. E. Duffield took seven for 48. Fourteen-year-old S. P. Bowling (fast) showed great potential in a modest attack; with more confidence the batting could have been more productive. **Nottingham HS** played some positive cricket, with excellent all-round performances from captain S. J. Turrill and P. A. J. Gregory contributing to their seven wins.

A careless approach by the potentially strong **Oakham** side was responsible for a disappointing season. **Oundle**, rebuilding their side, achieved a notable win v St Edward's, Oxford. An accurate attack was led by the captain M. N. Forbes (medium), but the batting was always uncertain.

The Perse School achieved wins v St Edmund's College, Chigwell, The Leys, and Kimbolton, but lost to Bishop's Stortford College, Bedford Modern, and Magdalen College School. **Plymouth College** had a successful season, with twelve wins. A. Seymour (slow left-arm) took 70 wickets and also headed the batting averages. I. T. Walcock kept wicket splendidly, and R. Wood was an effective captain. **Pocklington's** sixteen wins included those v Ampleforth, St Peter's York, Ashville College, Edinburgh Academy, and MCC. An accurate attack featured T. de L. Edmunds (left-arm medium), D. C. G. Wood (leg-spin) and captain A. E. C. Shanks (right-arm medium), who also headed the batting averages.

Unbeaten in 32 matches over two years, **Queen's College, Taunton**, lost their only game of the season to Plymouth College, with good wins v King's Taunton, Bishop's Stortford, Wellington, and King's Bruton. The wicket-keeping of N. Badat was outstanding.

A strong **Radley** attack was led by captain J. A. N. Wootten, whose off-spin took 49 wickets. Six of the eight schools played were bowled out, and wins were achieved v Bradfield, Malvern, St Edward's, and Stowe, the only defeat being by Marlborough. Highlights in a disappointing season for **Ratcliffe College** included the consistent bowling of N. Evans (left-arm medium-fast) and A. MacDiarmid's seven for 41 v The Gentlemen of Leicestershire. However, the batting lacked confidence. **Reading School** ended a mediocre season with wins v Douai and MCC. Outstanding wicket-keeper G. D. Beckett achieved ten stumpings and eight catches, as well as making a decisive contribution with the bat. All-rounder H. K. Mason opened the batting effectively and took seven for 42 v St Bartholomew's, Newbury. A. G. Brown (also a left-arm leg-spinner) bowled with increasing confidence and took four for 9 v Abingdon. The batting of **Reed's School** was led by P. E. E. Farenden and captain M. A. Rowland, who was selected for Sussex Second XI. Yet early promise was not fulfilled and the bowling tended to be expensive.

Regate GS, defeated only by RGS Colchester and Emanuel, owed much to captain N. J. Falkner whose 1,139 runs at 67.00 included four hundreds and seven fifties. He was well supported by all-rounders J. C. Perkins and C. D. Jones as well as fast bowler A. M. Babington. The team toured the Channel Islands in July. **Repton**, with wins v Shrewsbury and Worksop, benefited from the all-round ability of captain N. G. B. Richardson, who led the bowling for the third season. Fifteen-year-old left-hander S. W. Lovell had an outstanding first season with the bat. A young **Rossall** side, which defeated Sedbergh and Manchester GS, depended heavily on captain A. C. Jones, who batted prolifically. D. J. Hanson did the hat-trick v Arnold. **Royal Grammar School, Newcastle**, featured a strong batting side, with W. G. Wake, M. R. Thompson and A. G. Wilson playing for the Northumberland U. 19 side. With the bowlers lacking pace and experience, the number of wins was small. **Rydal School** were encouraged by the all-round performances of captain A. C. Rhodes (left-arm fast-medium) and T. C. N. Aughton, an opening right-hand bat and finger spinner who turned the ball both ways and who played for Welsh Schoolboys v MCC.

St Albans School improved towards the end of the season, with wins v Luton VI Form College and Bancroft's. The productive batting of A. J. Dent, T. R. Lovejoy and A. G. Lynes was well supported in depth, while accurate fielding and bowling were enhanced by the consistent wicket-keeping of N. J. Baker. The experienced batsmen of **St Dunstan's** were affected by examinations and illness, leaving a young team in which C. M. Denny and A. M. Ford showed promise. There was a good win v Surrey Young Cricketers. Prospects look good for **St Edmund's** with seven of their unbeaten side returning in 1981. Leading wicket-taker was K. A. Rumbelow, who took eight for 16 v Dover College. For **St Edward's School**, highlights included impressive batting performances by captain J. A. Lyons, N. A. Friend and P. R. J. Smith, while right-arm seam bowler N. H. M. Arkell took 21 wickets.

In an exciting season, with many close finishes, **St George's College** were indebted to punishing batsman D. A. Close and fifteen-year-old D. Hamer (medium-pace in-swinger) who took 34 wickets. **St John's School** were unbeaten by a school, their most notable victory being v St George's, Weybridge. The fielding was outstanding and captain A. G. K. Hooper gave an excellent all-round performance with 32 wickets (slow left-arm) and 295 runs; he and C. J. Presley both hit centuries v Surrey Young Cricketers. The side could have won more matches with another opening bowler of pace. All-rounder S. J. Billings ably led **St Lawrence College** for the second year. P. J. Laslett, batting at number eight, hit the school's first century for fourteen years.

The backbone of **St Peter's School** were C. J. Stubbs and A. M. Precious, who formed a left-arm opening attack and were also the leading batsmen. Captain M. W. Johnston (slow left-arm) was the leading wicket-taker. With a record ten wins, **Sedbergh School** defeated Ampleforth, Durham, Pocklington, Sherborne, Canford, William Hulme's GS, and RGS Newcastle. The fielding was excellent and the attack was led by outstanding fast bowler N. A. P. Meadows, whose 54 wickets set a school record and who played for MCC Schools. He received balanced and varied support from J. M. B. Daniels (medium), P. Rogers (off-spin) and J. L. O'B. Robinson (leg-spin). Captain W. R. Holdsworth had a fine season with the bat. A strong **Sevenoaks** side achieved easy wins over Ardingly and King's, Rochester. M. I. Dickenson batted reliably and kept wicket exceptionally, with eleven stumpings and nine catches in nine matches. P. Durdant-Hollamby showed class as an all-rounder, and P. N. Colman bowled left-arm orthodox and chinamen with remarkable control.

Sherborne's one defeat – to Sedbergh – came off the last ball after eight wickets had fallen for 12 runs in eight overs. J. F. Blackburn was an outstanding captain and capable all-rounder, while J. M. P. C. Turner was a consistent opening bat. The quality of the fielding was high. **Simon Langton GS** were unbeaten for the first time, their most memorable win being v Plymouth College during a tour in Devon. The steady attack was led by left-arm seamer F. Barrett and off-spinner A. Castle, with a best return of eight for 48. In a strong batting line-up, D. Simmonds received strong support from A. Wood. With eight players returning, prospects for 1981 are good. For **Sir Roger Manwood's School**, captain A. J. Curwen was the only batsman of note. Their opponents rarely mastered the right-arm off-spin of M. G. Norris who took eight for 11 v Duke of York's School; D. G. Chisholm (right-arm fast) took six for 20 in the win v St Lawrence, Ramsgate.

Solihull had a disappointing season, owing mainly to the failure of their leading batsmen. Of the bowlers, only N. J. Wheelwright (right-arm fast-medium) showed any consistency, and they were unable to bowl other sides out. **Stockport GS** won v Marple Hall, William Hulme's GS, and Cheadle Hulme, but were beaten by King's Macclesfield, King Edward's Lytham, and Arnold. Their middle order often failed to capitalise on a sound start from openers S. J. Hornby and A. E. Sawer. M. A. Beesley (right-arm fast) topped the bowling averages and P. D. Carroll (off-spin) took four for 1 v Marple Hall.

A young and promising **Strathallan** side were ably led by C. A. MacLeod, in his second year as captain. Outstanding performer for **Sutton Valence School** was M. T. Russell-Vick (right-arm medium) who topped both the batting and bowling averages and was selected for the HMC Schools (South) U. 15. He was well supported by R. J. Bedford (right-arm medium out-swing), while captain J. B. Hitchens was competent both with the bat and behind the stumps.

In a season of contrasts, **Taunton School** had good wins v Clifton, Downside, and Bishop's Stortford, but disappointing defeats v Bryanston and Blundell's. Their captain D. M. Elworthy, who hit a century v Downside, was selected for the Public Schools XI. A successful **Tiffin** side, with twelve wins, was indebted to captain-wicket-keeper A. J. Stewart, whose 782 runs included two centuries. N. D. Hicks gave him useful support. Spinners dominated the attack, with right-arm leg-spinner M. S. G. Robins and off-spinner S. P. Clews heading the averages. They won the Surrey Schools knockout trophy, beating Beverley School in the final.

Tonbridge School tailed off towards the end of the season after a promising start with wins v Christ's Hospital and Haileybury. Two fifteen-year-olds showed promise – G. R. Cowdrey with the bat and M. P. Hickson as an all-rounder. For **Trent College**, bowling honours were shared by J. C. Harris (right-arm fast), I. Lane (off-spin) and all-rounders M. R. Dodson and N. C. Green (both right-arm fast-medium). The batting, often brittle, relied heavily on captain D. N. Wood. **Trinity's** bowling lacked penetration, although J. R. Glynn-Jones (fast-medium) took 55 wickets. Outstanding wicket-keeper S. N. Perry set two school records, claiming 45 victims in the season and seven in an innings. The batting was prolific with J. E. Vigar hitting three centuries and M. L. Jones scoring two. In their Centenary Year, **Truro School** lost to only one school side. The highlight of the season was right-arm seamer M. E. Barlow's performance v The Past Captains XI, when he took four wickets in four balls.

A young **University College School** side showed considerable promise, the most encouraging performance coming from thirteen-year-old H. Sharp who hit 65 not out v Mill Hill and took seven for 21 v Abingdon. Generally the bowling lacked penetration and the batting tended to be brittle, although M. Furness played some useful innings. J. Brenner was the school's best wicket-keeper for many years. Careless fielding and uneconomical bowling denied **Uppingham** a win, despite the outstanding batting performances of captain J. J. Whitaker, whose 747 runs surpassed by 25 the previous record set in 1893. He hit three centuries, reaching a hundred before lunch v MCC.

Warwick School were unbeaten, but managed only one school win – v Dean Close. In the absence of a good slow bowler, the attack lacked variety, all four main bowlers bowling right-arm medium pace. The batting, led by R. A. Horner, had depth but lacked consistency. With an inexperienced side, **Wellington, Berkshire**, could not adapt to the soft wickets, defeating Charterhouse but losing to Harrow, Winchester, Bradfield, and Stowe. S. P. Loup was the steadiest bowler. Inconsistent batting and the absence of a competent spinner contributed to a disappointing season for **Westminster**, although captain S. M. Beadle played some determined

innings, and both G. A. C. Davies and R. S. Rutnagur showed promise as all-rounders. Weak batting caused a young **Whitgift** side often to be bowled out cheaply, but their strength lay in a tight attack, featuring G. J. McEwan (right-arm fast) and sixteen-year-old R. D. Ronald (slow left-arm).

Though beating Sutton Valence, **William Hulme's GS** suffered defeats by Shrewsbury, Sedbergh, and St Peter's York. A fragile middle order failed to support solid foundations laid by openers S. P. Dickinson and A. P. Laker as well as captain D. B. Wright. Left-arm seamer P. A. Cotterill led the attack, and young leg-spinner N. R. Fairfax showed promise late in the season. **Winchester's** strong point was their bowling; of the four schools to be defeated – Clifton, Wellington, Charterhouse, and Eastbourne – three were bowled out for less than 100. Opening bowlers A. R. Crocker (right-arm medium-fast) and M. B. H. Wheeler (right-arm fast-medium) took 89 wickets between them, Wheeler taking six for 13 v Clifton. Crocker played for the second successive year for the Southern Schools and the Public Schools.

In the absence of a penetrative opening bowler, **Woodhouse Grove School** had only a moderate season. D. A. and J. M. Robinson (both right-arm fast-medium) were the mainstays of the attack and were supported by S. Cockerill (left-arm fast-medium) and S. A. J. Kippax (leg-breaks and googlies). S. N. Driver and D. A. Robinson dominated the batting with the promising I. W. Stott, who came into the side halfway through the season. Indifferent batting restricted **Worksop College**, where S. N. Waddington – right-arm fast-medium and a useful bat – showed himself to be a fine prospect. After being outplayed in their first four matches, **Wycliffe College** staged a dramatic recovery and were unbeaten in their last ten encounters. The transformation came with a spectacular return to form by the captain, F. J. Hemming-Allen, who became the first Wycliffe batsman ever to top 500 runs in a season.
