



THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN 1967

It would have been surprising if school cricket had been powerful in 1967. The young cricketer is particularly handicapped by bad weather at the start of the season. All schools suffered from the unusually wet May, and for some the month was virtually a write-off. *Rydal* and *Monmouth* were perhaps hardest hit. Of their 18 fixtures nine were abandoned, eight of them suffering that fate in May and *Monmouth* had their first six washed out completely. *Malvern* had five matches spoiled during the month, and a potentially powerful side had difficulty in settling down. Nevertheless, they emerged from the season with one of the best records among the larger, and normally stronger, cricketing schools with six wins and only one defeat.

The effects of a rain-marred term were evident when the representative teams gathered at Lord's. The general standard of play was moderate, and some of those in their second season of representative schools cricket had not made the expected advances. An exception was D. R. Owen-Thomas, whose all-round play contributed greatly to the best season ever enjoyed by *K.C.S., Wimbledon*. They won nine matches and lost none. Owen-Thomas made 815 runs and took 48 wickets, averaging 58 with the bat and 12.9 with the ball. In both departments he was well supported, and the fielding, it is reported, "often rose to great heights", including the outstanding wicket-keeping of J. Spalton.

Owen-Thomas also distinguished himself at Lord's, but the schoolboy player of the week there was not an Englishman but an Indian. The *Indian Schools* were touring Britain for the first time and at Lord's they made a great impression against the representative British Schools team, whom they defeated in dramatic circumstances by five wickets. Their star was Surendar Amarnath, one of two sons of India's former Test captain playing in the match. His 104 not out snatched very well deserved victory after the most desperate race against the clock. With only two balls remaining of what seemed likely to be the last over, the Indians were nine short of the 203 they needed, and Surendar was 92. By hitting the first of those two balls over midwicket and high into the Mound Stand, Surendar made sure that it would be the last over. When the ball was retrieved, there was no possibility of time allowing another to be started. For the Indians it was now all or nothing with the English fielders far flung to patrol the boundaries. The only sure winner was another hit carrying the boundary out of reach of those fielders. That was precisely what Surendar achieved, another magnificent six in the same direction.

Surendar, a left hander, began impressively with a splendid cover drive to the boundary in his first over, and from that point his batting had the unmistakable stamp of class. Until the final fling the off side stroke play was the feature of his splendid innings. Raja Mukerjee, his partner in a third-wicket stand of 143, was an eminently sound opening batsman whose play was hardly less impressive. Until he was run out the Indians seemed likely to win overwhelmingly with the loss of only two wickets.

If the form shown by the Indian boys is any guide to the future, India's role in world cricket is due to become considerably greater. India's recent Test performances have been modest, largely because they fail to apply their skills to the best advantage. Obviously gifted cricketers play in a hesitant manner. They give the impression of being equally afraid of losing and winning. The excuse has been made that the extremely slow pace of their pitches, which are true but dead, is a severe handicap which stifles enterprise. It is not a valid excuse so far as batsmen, at least, are concerned, and it was interesting to note that the Indian schoolboys had not been influenced by it. They played positive, purposeful cricket and contributed importantly to the British school season.

Before the batsmen showed their paces so excitingly their bowlers had disposed of the pick of the home boy players for 202. They fielded excellently, and S. M. H. Kirmani took a superb tumbling catch at mid-off. Their spin bowling was impressive, with Arun Kumar showing equal proficiency as leg spinner and off spinner, and the other Amarnath, Mohinder, took the first four wickets in a spell of 15 overs costing 32. At medium pace he varied his pace and flight skilfully. Dipankar Sarkar, another leg spinner, also took four wickets deservedly, and, if the opening bowling was ordinary, there seemed possibilities about Jitendra Bhuta, who had some pretensions to pace.

Without Owen-Thomas the home side would have been severely trounced. He made 91, and the only other batsman to resist the Indian bowlers long was C. G. Ruck (*Uppingham*), who shared a stand of 68 for the fifth wicket. Until he recklessly threw away his chance of a century Owen-Thomas batted with mature authority. He looked more than a class above all the other home batsmen. His footwork was quick and sure, and he had scoring strokes all round the wicket, most notably the on-drive, the most difficult stroke in the game to play surely. Instead of the forward defensive stab, which was Trevor Bailey's strength but a weakness in many other modern batsmen, Owen-Thomas on a true and predictable pitch let his bat follow through when playing forward defensively. On a pitch with pace in it such a stroke, though defensively played, is liable to produce a few runs. The forward defensive stab cannot do so.

In the next match, against Combined Services, Owen-Thomas again stood between his side and disaster, though in fact a final

total of 97 was not far removed from it. His share was 39 but his play was far from being so emphatic as on the previous day. Perhaps he was feeling the strain of again having to support a weak side. Yet his pawky play on this occasion did not upset the excellent impression he had already made. He was clearly indicated as the best home batsman of the season.

Anyone who had seen the representative games of 1966 would have expected K. Griffith of *Worcester Royal Grammar School* to challenge him for that position. At Lord's, where he had played so well and confidently a year earlier, Griffith consistently failed to get going. It is never a bad thing for a young player to suffer a set-back after initial success, which if continued uninterrupted might give him the wrong impression of the game's difficulties. At school during the term, however, he suffered no sort of set-back. He headed the batting averages with 61, scoring 428, also the bowling by taking 36 wickets with his off spinners at 7.58, and Worcester had another good season.

Ruck, the only other batsman to acquit himself worthily against the Indian boys, was a good, sound player. He quickly made friends with older spectators by getting off the mark with a boldly lofted drive, and that stroke and the cut were subsequently his most telling scorers. The remainder of the batsmen did little to impress us with their potentialities, though M. Heal (*St. Brendan's College*) played a brave second innings of 53 against Combined Services. That the latter won easily by eight wickets was not surprising. This was not a good year for school batting, and doubtless the rainy month of May was largely responsible.

In the circumstances it would be churlish to criticise technical failings. Criticism is, however, valid when applied to the over rate of the boys. Throughout the representative games the rate was consistently well below 20 an hour. Combined Services, who should be very careful to set the boys a good example in all such matters, did not help with their 111 balls an hour on the first day of their match. In one respect, however, their bowlers did set an admirable example. Not one of them indulged in the time wasting and totally useless modern practice of doing a dummy run before starting a bowling spell. The boys themselves had learned that bad habit from other seniors.

The villains are those who set a thoroughly bad example in big cricket. What they do is quickly and faithfully reproduced at all lower levels, and many of their habits are not for export. They include practices which are politely described as gamesmanship. Cricket masters at the schools have, except on odd occasions, managed to dissuade their charges from imitating the more venal offences. They have not, however, succeeded in keeping their over rates up to acceptable standards. The Indian Schools averaged 113 balls an hour, their English opponents 109. In the entire day,

six hours and twenty minutes of actual play, 116.1 overs were bowled.

Comparisons between players of different eras are in most cases difficult to the point of being virtually impossible. None can say with any pretence at accuracy how Grace compared with Hobbs, how Trumper compared with Bradman. None can say whether Tyson was faster than Larwood or Kortright, Lindwall faster than McDonald or Jones, and exactly how Hall of the present era compares with any of them. In the matter of over rates the comparison is simple. The figures tell the precise story, and it is one that reflects very badly on the present-day game at all levels, not least in schools cricket. At Lord's in 1967 we had a match lasting the full day and producing 116.1 overs. Forty years earlier I played in a Lord's Schools v. The Rest match reduced by rain on the first day to a single day. The overs bowled numbered 144.4—171 balls more than in 1967. The game has in fact slowed down by $4\frac{1}{2}$ overs an hour, a drop of almost twenty per cent, and it has virtually all happened in the past fifteen years.

I have gone into this matter at length, because a brisk over rate is the essential core of a cricket match. Even when we expected 22 overs an hour in Test cricket—England at Lord's in 1930 averaged 23 while Australia were scoring 729 for six, of which Bradman made 254—cricket was described as a slow game. Now, when we are lucky to get 18 an hour, it has become too slow to maintain sufficient spectator interest to keep the first-class game financially prosperous. In the past two years the game's rulers have taken steps to boost the county game's tempo. Their players have frustrated them. Before the 1966 season they set 20 overs an hour as the acceptable minimum. Three out of 17 counties reached the target. Again before the 1967 summer they demanded 20, but only one this time complied. Gloucestershire alone met requirements. Perhaps in this matter at least we should ask a lower level to set the example for the top. If those in charge of schools cricket send players into the adult game accustomed to getting through 21 or 22 overs an hour, perhaps future generations will be given enough actual cricket in a six-hour day to satisfy them. I wonder how many of the large number of school games left drawn in 1967 would have reached definite conclusions, if one more over had been bowled in each hour.

The bowling of the boys at Lord's was on a par with the batting. Only Du Boulay (*Repton*) and Griffith among those who played against the Indians and Combined Services had good sideways actions. Du Boulay was a bowler of pace with the outswinger as his main armament. For school cricket he was emphatically fast. So was J. H. Walker (*King's, Macclesfield*), but he was erratic, which was not surprising, for his action was not so pure. A good sideways action, which allows the arm to swing straight in the

direction of the far wicket, is a fair guarantee of accuracy of direction at least. Control of direction is an altogether different matter for the open-chester, whose arm swings across his body from leg to off. Griffith potentially was obviously the best of the spinners, and it was surprising, indeed, that his skipper did not bowl him at all against the Services. He was certainly better than Ruck, the other off spinner who had an action that suggested he would bowl leg breaks. M. Riley (*Moseley Hall G.S.*), who replaced A. K. U. Ollennu (*Lancing*) for the second match, looked a useful left arm spinner. He marred an otherwise good action by crouching during the delivery. He also showed himself to be a batsman with a good off drive but a somewhat disorganised defence. Ollennu, a cheerful, rotund customer from Africa, was a leg-break bowler eminently fitted to scare the life out of boy opponents, but too slow through the air to disturb the confidence of more experienced opponents. For *Lancing* he took 40 wickets at 17 each, and I would wager that his major performances came in inter-school games. The Schools attack was completed by the medium pace, decidedly useful despite an open-chested action, of M. J. Boyers (*Sir George Monoux*)

Several schools reported well of their fielding, and this branch of the game was certainly satisfying at Lord's. It was keen and good, and Heal was particularly alert and sure. Against the Indians they threw excellently also. Against the Services much of their throwing was wild. Add that to the generally hesitant batting, and we may fairly conclude that the boys were overawed by the occasion and not seen at their best.

Despite the difficult start to the season some schools had good reason to be pleased with their results. K.C.S., Wimbledon, were not the only unbeaten side. *Chigwell*, whose captain, J. E. Smith, averaged 53.55 with a total of 482, had five wins set against four draws. *King's, Taunton*, unbeaten for the second year running, had a similar record to that of K.C.S. with nine wins. R. G. Poynton, the skipper, did not repeat his scoring feats of 1966, when he averaged 78, but his bowling was even more effective, 41 wickets at 7.36. *Oakham* also had a splendid season, their best since 1954. R. H. Robinson and S. D. Datt were their openers for the third year. Their fine scoring, Robinson 335 and Datt 334, gave a good bowling side the chance to win six matches.

Several sides went through the season unbeaten by another school, including *Pocklington* for the third time in succession. Their only defeat came after they had declared at 205 for four against their Old Boys. The heaviest scorer was C. Aldred, whose 485 gave him an average of 53.88. Among the schools whose opposition is in the strongest range, *Marlborough* and *Malvern* were unbeaten by a School rival. *Marlborough* had a particularly promising batsman in R. B. M. Johnston, who was just 15 and averaged nearly 30. The captain, R. E. Percival, kept wicket excellently and the fast left-arm

bowler, R. J. Freedman, took 38 wickets. After their damp start *Malvern* did not consider that their potentially powerful side really settled down. Yet their results were admirable, with six wins against a single defeat. Their bowling was steady, their batting exceptionally strong and they had a splendid record against other schools. Three batsmen, H. J. Tunnicliffe, P. J. Allerton and I. A. R. Murray, had averages above 45, and the School could well have had a representative in the Southern Schools v. The Rest match at Beckenham, which preceded the representative games at Lord's.

Alleyn's and *Canford* also completed their inter-school programme unbeaten. A. P. L. Williams scored more runs, 630 with an average of 52.5, than any other *Alleyn's* batsman in a season. In so doing he surpassed M. J. Stewart, the present captain of Surrey. Another who contributed much to the success of the team was a 14-year-old leg break and googly bowler, R. B. Rice, who took 23 wickets at 12.96 each. *Canford* won seven games in a row after starting with three draws, and were unbeaten until they met Free Foresters in their final match. The medium paced bowling of B. R. Volonterio accounted for 47 wickets, which cost only 6.6 each.

Eastbourne celebrated their Centenary with five wins against one defeat and a school record for an individual score, when M. T. Barford made 152 against *Lancing*. Barford was the heaviest scorer with 519, but his average of 47 was exceeded by M. I. Gourlay's 50.28 from a total of 352. Several others were beaten only once, and *Ardingly*, for whom J. E. Hall averaged 47.62, narrowly missed going through the season without losing. Their only defeat, by *Caterham*, was by the narrow margin of five runs. Among the others who lost only once were *Eton* and *Haileybury*, both of whom enjoyed batting power as insurance against defeat, but whose bowling was not strong enough to give them many wins. *Eton* won only twice and *Haileybury* three times. The former's pace bowling, headed by Viscount Crowhurst, was good enough but missed the necessary support of spin. M. J. J. Faber, averaging 43, was the leading batsman in a side that was never completely dismissed by a school side. *Haileybury* had eight batsmen with averages over 20, including A. F. Stewart, who was first among them with 32.6.

Single losers in the North included *St. Peter's, York, Sedbergh, Rossall, Pocklington, Lancaster Grammar School, Stockport Grammar School* and *Bradford Grammar School*, who dismissed all their opponents for fewer than 100, including *St. Peter's*. Three *Bradford* bowlers, A. P. Smith, R. S. Brewerton and P. S. Sykes, together took 67 wickets at the modest cost of 7.4 runs each. Apart from losing to *Bradford, St. Peter's* were as successful as usual. The highlight of their season was an innings of 114 not out by N. G. A. Morris which included eleven 6's and six 4's. They inflicted the only defeat on *Sedberg*, whose batsmen prospered despite the

unprecedented wet weather, particularly W. H. Shucksmith with a top score of 107 not out and an average of 46.

Uppingham, whom Ruck represented well at Lord's, lost only to Cambridge Crusader's. Ruck contributed 385 runs and 22 wickets. *Oundle*, though beaten three times, also did well in the Midlands group. Good bowling and fielding was largely responsible for their best season for several years. *St. Edward's*, Oxford, lost only once. Their batting was so strong that six players averaged more than 25, and they had an impressive record against other schools.

A particularly notable record was that of *King's, Canterbury*. Although they began the term without a single old colour, they had seven wins to set against four defeats. Their season was made striking by the versatile performances of C. J. C. Rowe, school cricket's version of the one-man band. At the age of 15 he was the top batsman and top bowler. With the bat his top score was 103 not out and his total 548. In the field he bowled leg breaks and googlies with his right hand and off breaks and googlies with his left. His five for 32 against Eastbourne contained three wickets while bowling left-handed. South Africa's great all-rounder G. A. Faulkner bowled googlies with his left hand in the nets almost as well as with his right, though there is no record, so far as I know, of his using his left-handed bowling in match play.

King Edward's, Birmingham, who beat *Denstone* for the first time in five years, and *Ipswich* both claimed exceptional seasons. *Denstone's* successes on other occasions owed much to the batting of the captain, R. L. Short, who had a total of 455 and played an innings of 156 to beat *Nottingham High School*. The latter also had an outstanding player in their captain, for P. D. Johnson topped both sets of averages, his figures 53.7 and 14.63, and his 63 wickets brought his total for the School side to 317. *Dean Close*, beaten only by *Wycliffe, Dauntsey's*—their "best side for years"—*Highgate*, who won five of their six inter-School matches, *Sherborne, Millfield* and *Dulwich* were also among the successful. Splendid fielding served *Sherborne* well, and *Millfield*, for whom C. J. Perry was a batting bulwark and J. I. Graveney, son of J. K. and nephew of T. W. Graveney, was a good all-rounder, attributed their nine wins to a policy of giving the opposition first innings. That evidence that batting second pays is, however, upset by the experience of *Reed's School, Cobham*. They won four and lost four, and on every occasion the side batting first won the match.

Dulwich, for whom S. Dyson made 487 runs and took 31 wickets, played enterprising cricket with excellent results. Their outstanding performance was the hitting of 237 for four in three hours to beat M.C.C. *Tonbridge* near by were a sound team, lacking experience but still returning a fair record against strong opposition. The same could be said of *Winchester*. They also had a splendid win over M.C.C. against the clock, when they hit off the necessary 250,

including the final 81 in forty minutes. They drew four of their inter-school matches and beat *Bradfield* by 23 runs. The batting of J. M. Bebb, 443 runs and the off-spin bowling of A. S. G. Thompson, who took seven for 39 against *Bradfield*, played a large part in their performances. Though N. R. C. Fyler had a fine season as an all-rounder, *Bradfield* suffered from unreliable batting after making a promising start. *Harrow* were obviously a useful side, with the batting of A. P. Webster and R. S. Crawley and the spin bowling of I Coomeraswamy and Webster.

That spin bowling combinations were prominent was a pleasing feature of the season in an age more usually dominated by seam. *Brighton, Bristol Grammar School, Charterhouse, Felsted*, who gained eight victories, *Shrewsbury* and *Worksop* had good reason to be thankful for their spinners. S. C. Corlett's off spin took 54 wickets at only 9.6 for *Worksop*. Fast scoring, individually and by teams, was another welcome feature. On successive days of the Cambridge tour made by *Newcastle Royal Grammar School*, J. C. Campbell made 107 and 123 not out in just over an hour on each occasion. A comparable performance was D. A. Guest's 113 in seventy-seven minutes, including six 6's and twelve 4's, for *Bristol G.S.* against *Colston's School*. *Ellesmere's* defeat of Zambia Eagles touring side was due to their skipper, K. R. Bayliss, making 110 in two hours, twenty minutes, the highest score for the school for many years. The most consistently rapid scoring, reminiscent of I. P. Campbell's feats for *Canford* in the early post-war years, was done by G. Coles for *The Perse School*. During the term he made 573 runs and averaged above a run a minute. Coles hit 71 not out in fifty-five minutes against M.C.C., 84 in sixty-nine minutes against a Cambridgeshire County XI and 80 not out in seventy-eight minutes against *Tiffin's*. *Enterprise* collectively also saved *Cheltenham*, whose batting suffered a mid-season slump, in their final match against *Haileybury*, when they scored 367 for five in their second innings, after seeming set for defeat.

In addition to those bowling performances already noted others remain to be mentioned, particularly that of D. M. Retallack for *St. John's, Leatherhead*. He was exceptionally fast for school cricket but unfortunately was injured and absent for much of the season. When he returned to the side he promptly did two hat-tricks in ten balls, clean bowling five of his victims. Another genuinely fast bowler, J. C. Dazell (*Bedford*) took 11 for 72 against *Tonbridge*. M. P. G. Moody had eight for 19 while bowling *Dover* to victory against *Brighton*, and R. F. A. Lane's 42 wickets at 9.66, bowling fast medium for *Epsom*, was a fine season's work. At *Gresham's*, Holt I. S. R. Colquhoun's 45 wickets equalled the school record of A. J. Corran, the former *Nottinghamshire* captain.

In Scotland, *Merchiston* inflicted on *Loretto* their only defeat. *George Watson's*, who were unbeaten by another school for the

first time since the war, also lost once only. For *George Watson's* R. B. Thompkin's six for 22 against *Fettes* and M. Maciocia's 112 in five minutes under two hours against their Former Pupils were among the outstanding individual performances of the season. The batting of K. D. M. Wilson, 431 runs, and the left-arm spin of C. D. C. Henderson, 37 wickets at 9.4, were the big factors in *Loretto's* outstanding successes. Despite moderate batting *Fettes* had a fair season, helped by the 40 cheaply taken wickets of M. C. L. Gill. *Glenalmond*, whose averages were headed by D. S. Gordon, had a similar record, and *George Heriot's*, with an unusually young side, won five and lost only two matches. *Edinburgh Academy* had what they termed "a luckless season", only one victory and nine defeats.

It remains only to mention the first of the representative games at Lord's, in which the Public Schools reversed last year's results by defeating the English Schools Cricket Association. It was, however, not exactly convincing as an act of revenge, for wet weather turned the game into a restricted one of 35 overs each. Despite defeat by eight wickets, the E.S.C.A. provided seven of the 12 players who figured in the final two representative games. Some of those on the winning side, accustomed to strong opposition, who were overlooked, might have strengthened the representative schools side.

SOUTH AFRICAN SCHOOLS TOUR, 1967

By CHARLES BURTON

The second South African Schools side to visit England enjoyed a most successful tour, notable for the enterprising cricket played and the popularity of the team on and off the field. Moreover the tour was blessed with fine weather and, unlike the 1963 tour, no game was spoilt by rain.

Of 17 games, only two were lost. The ten victories included convincing ones over Combined English Schools XI at Stowe (ten wickets), Harrow (five wickets), Clifton (100 runs), Marlborough (five wickets), Sherborne (ten wickets), Eastbourne (178 runs). A strong Schools side raised by Mr. Hubert Doggart, President of the English Schools Cricket Association, were also well beaten (110 runs), as were a strong Public Schools Wanderers side which included the Schools coach, G. A. Innes, and another South African Test player, S. F. Burke, the South African Universities tour coach (six wickets); Sussex Martlets (75 runs) and Standard Bank (131 runs). In three drawn matches the South Africans were poised for victory, but were lucky to escape defeat against R. J. O. Meyer's Eleven at Millfield.

The first of the two defeats was against a powerful side raised and captained by G. N. S. Ridley, Oxford captain and himself a member of the 1963 South African Schools touring side, and including G. A. Innes, F. S. Goldstein, Oxford's opening batsman from Bulawayo and R. Muzzell of the South African Universities touring side. Although the Schools did well to total 235, Goldstein, Muzzell and Innes hit Ridley's side to victory by four wickets. The other defeat was in the last match against the English Schools at Winchester, when for once the tourists' bowlers met their masters.

Collins, the captain, made most runs in a strong batting side, and Cheetham and Orchard each scored centuries. There were five century partnerships. The bowling honours were shared by Tayfield, Orchard and Featherstone, but Bredenkamp, McLoughlin and Hubbard proved their worth on more than one occasion. The fielding until the last match against the English Schools was first-class, and van der Spuy and Madsen both proved capable wicket-keepers.

The players were fortunate in having as manager Roy Gathorne, who with his genial assistant and coach, Gerald Innes, were popular shepherds of their flock as well as ideal ambassadors of South African cricket.

ALL-INDIA SCHOOLS' TOUR OF THE U.K., 1967

Reciprocating the visit made to their country by the London Schools side in 1965-66, the All-India Schools team arrived in London in mid-July and after an extensive and successful tour left for Bombay at the end of August.

The party of 16 players, captained by Ajit Naik of Bombay, was managed by Lt.-Col. H. R. Adhikari with two officials of the India Board of Control, M. B. L. Mathur and S. Sahu, completing the party. As events turned out the Indian schoolboys were much too strong for their opponents and were only rarely extended. With rain preventing any play at Old Trafford, the tourists won nine matches and drew eight. Their supremacy lay in quite exceptional batting strength and a battery of wrist spinners whose subtleties were too complex for most batsmen.

The batting find of the tour was Laxman Singh, not yet 15, whose skill is such that he must surely be reckoned in terms of the senior side. In sixteen innings he scored 973 runs, with five centuries and three half centuries to return an average of 74.8. Several other batsmen distinguished themselves; Raja Mukherjee showed that he had all the qualities required of an opener and while less dashing than his partner Laxman Singh he nonetheless scored 610 runs. S. M. H. Kirmani, a hard-hitting driver of the ball, proved his worth by scoring 491 runs, while Surendar Amarnath played two innings of real distinction; scoring his first century in England at Lord's, he gave his side victory against the M.C.C. Combined Schools by hitting the last two balls of the match for successive 6's and he followed this feat up by plundering another from the Gloucester/Bristol schools side at Bristol.

The bowling figures make interesting reading, because of the 208 wickets to fall, 154 went to the spinners, of whom the most outstanding were D. Sarkar (leg-spin) and Jasbir Singh (slow left-arm). Sarkar took most wickets—65 at 11.16 each—and showed such mastery that nobody could tire of watching him perplex his opponents. Jasbir Singh, who dismissed 52 batsmen at 9.09, was unlucky not to have taken more wickets, for his bowling suffered from dropped catches. The only real weakness in the team lay in the fast and medium-fast bowling departments.

The manager spent a great deal of time during the practice sessions on fielding and although the catching did not always come up to expectations the ground fielding and throwing were excellent.

Throughout their stay the tourists were greeted with enthusiasm and were well looked after.

The Indian selectors, the manager and his boys can be happy with the performances put up by the team, who were at all times well-disciplined and friendly and who, fortunately for those concerned, brought their own weather with them, for in 46 days rain only interfered with one and a half days' cricket.
